PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear fellow Life-Changing Rotarians,

Greetings!

Across the Rotary world, September is dedicated to remembering, appreciating, and implementing projects focusing on **Education and Literacy**. Basic education and literacy is essential for reducing poverty, improving health, encouraging community and economic development, and promoting peace. With great pride, Our Club has not only been productive in this area of focus, but we have even implemented a collation of

projects covering all the seven (7) areas of focus intended to address the continuing needs of our community amid or in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

In the month of September alone, we already have implemented four (4) projects concerning or in response to COVID-19, as follows:

1. **VACtoNormal: Road to Recovery** [A Two-Part Seminar on COVID-19 and the Importance of Vaccination] *(Basic Education & Literacy; Disease Prevention & Treatment)*

Our Club believes that proper and adequate knowledge about, and attitude towards, COVID-19 is key to preventing and controlling this pandemic. Hence, constantly-updated educational programs relating to COVID-19 will surely contribute to improving our community's knowledge, awareness, and attitude towards COVID-19.

As our implementing project, we launched

VACtoNormal: Road to Recovery

and dedicated two meetings for this initiative. This project consisted of a two-part seminar: the first seminar (held on September 14, 2021) was about COVID-19's & other significant information regarding COVID-19 vaccination, while the second seminar

(held on September 28, 2021) focused on the importance of COVID 19 Vaccination & its implication on the young, elderly, those persons with comorbidity. Our Club had invited two medical experts to render a talk about these seminars, namely **Dr. Gerard Garcia and Dr. Alexander Tan, Jr.**, respectively. Both events were well-received, with 75 & 55 participants, respectively, including fellow Rotarians, professionals, businessmen, and others coming from all walks of life.

Streamers regarding COVID-19 vaccination campaign and

Rotary: People of Action Membership Drive

were likewise displayed at strategic public areas in the municipality of Minglanilla and the City of Talisay. This was purposed not only to make our Club's efforts visible, but also to encourage and amplify the need to be vaccinated as soon as possible.

2. **Project DAKILA (Damay-an at Kilusan sa Iisang Laban sa COVID-19)** *(Disease Prevention & Treatment)*

In this project, our Club provided frontline health workers with PPEs, masks, oxygen tanks, and whatever they would need to serve COVID-19 patients and persons needing isolation.

The first wave of this happened with the turnover of hospital kits such as Oxygen Tanks with regulator set, oximeters, alcohol, vitamins, pillows, face masks to Barili Communiuty Hospital and

San Fernando Municipal Hall. This was in partnership with the Sacred Heart School – Jesuit, Batch 2007.

3. **Project AKAP (Alay sa Kapwa)** *(Community Economic Development)*

In this project, our Club helped in gathering resources to help quarantined families cope with COVID-19, where like in the story, we multiply the blessings of "Five Loaves, Two Fish" to serve more and change lives.

4. **Songs for a Cause (Fundraising Activity)** *(Community Economic Development)*

This was to augment the financing of **PROJECTS DAKILA AND AKAP** where interested persons may request our Rotarians Anton and Glynis to sing their song of choice from any generation and artist in exchange for a pledge of Php200.00 per song. These songs were performed in FB Live last September 12, 2021.

Our event was graced by our very own District Governor Anna Louissa Bumagat, Past District Governor Mary Anne Solomon, Assistant Governors Michael Torres and Jensen Racho, and fellow life-changing Rotarians & friends. We greatly appreciate their support and generosity in this project, enabling us to touch more lives.

Our Club's other projects geared toward sustaining our community in the midst of the pandemic include:

5. **Laban Labangon: Love gift to Sitio Labsalex, Labangon fire victims**

(Peace Building & Conflict Prevention; Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene)

In this project, Our Club turned over relief goods to 840 survivor-families of Sitio Labsalex, Barangay Labangon, Cebu City, whose homes and properties were recently razed by fire last September 25, 2021. We shared our blessings and resources them, such as vitamins, rice, bottled water, biscuits, noodles, and used clothing. May God's love touch their hearts in times of adversity.

6. **Formation of Rotary Community Corps of Guba Community** *(Economic & Community Development ; Basic Literacy & Education)*

In addition, our Club had the ceremonial MOA-signing with our charter, the Rotary Community Corps of Brgy. Guba.

We also conducted a Kick-off Orientation to twenty (20) community volunteers as future members of Guba RCC by educating them the value of teamwork, volunteerism, and service above self. We then ended with a fellowship, strengthening our bonds of friendship and camaraderie with Guba RCC.

7. **Tree Planting Activity** *(Environment)*

We also had our Tree Planting activity together with the newly-inducted charter members and officers of the RCC of Guba in Sitio Cambilog, Barangay Guba. Our Club is driven to protect the right of our people to a balanced and healthful ecology, which entails a correlative duty to preserve and restore nature and the environment.

8. **Project HOPE (Health, Opportunities, Protection and Education)**

(Mother & Child Health and Disease Prevention & Treatment)

This project was achieved by turning over vitamins and antibiotics to Barangay Guba Community Hospital with the support of our Assistant Governor Jensen Racho. This was intended to serve and sustain the mothers and children in the said locality with a total population of 5,732 people.

9. **Communal Water Source Project** *(Water, Sanitation & Hygiene)*

We also revisited the 10-year old Communal Water Source Project donated by Our Club. Our Club is now exploring on the possibility of applying for a global grant in connecting three (3) neighboring Sitios from this water source to simultaneously augment these Sitios' farming livelihood.

We hope that we can do more in the months to come and truly *Serve to Change Lives*. Our little acts of showing kindness, sharing love, and touching lives, when accumulated and done together, will verily create great and lasting impact in the communities we serve.

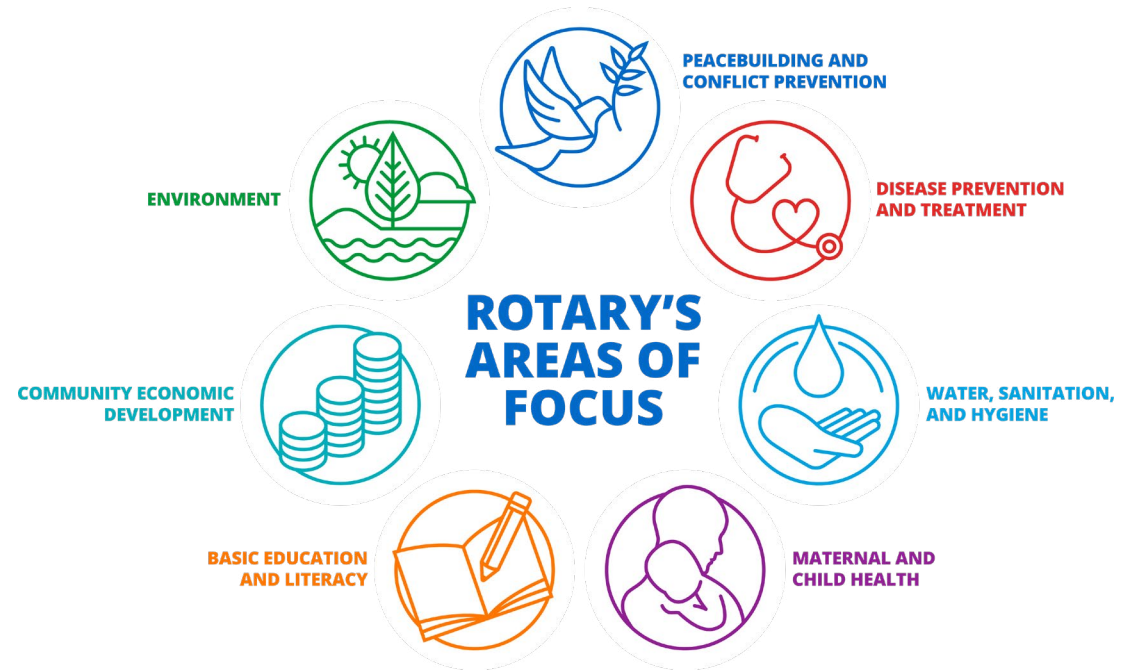
