We kicked off the beginning of the month with an in-person Official District Governor's Visit.

District Governor Anna Louisa Bumagat and her spouse Past Assistant Governor Troy Bumagat, **District Executive Secretary** Caroline Andrade, and Assistant Governor for Area 1C Jensen Racho graced our club with their presence and support. We inducted one new Rotarian, Mr. Rafael "Mandy" Medel, who was charged and inducted by no less than our District Governor and District Secretary. We then had our warm, fun-filled, and exciting fellowship right after the formalities of the said visit.

> Our Club is also very proud to be recognized during the District Awarding Ceremony for donors of The **Rotary Foundation** (TRF) last November 13 as the first Club in the District to be an allmember giving Club the Foundation. known as "Every Rotarian Every Year" Club and also being a 100% Sustaining Member Club. More importantly, the entire membership club's has also become part of the Paul Harris Fellowship and RCBM is now just waiting for

the awarding of the 100% Paul Harris Fellow Club banner from TRF and the District! Congratulations to our Club, our dear RCBM, for this great milestone in its history.

Our Club's external

affairs had likewise been productive. We held last November 7 our Club's Operation Tuli activity at Barangay Cogon in Compostela, Cebu with Cebu Lodge 128 and Talisay Sugbu Lodge No. 422, and with fellow medical volunteers from emergency Rescue Unit Foundation (ERUF) and Cebu Institute of Medicine (CIM) team, spearheaded by Dr. Jesus Ravanes. This project finally pushed through after several postponements caused bν health restrictions associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. As a registered nurse, it was very fulfilling to perform circumcision operation again. We were able to circumcise a total of 165 bovs. Our club also turned over antibiotics and vitamins to the Barangay.

On November 13, we also turned over pillows, medicines and vitamins to "My Bonita Home for Girls" for sexually-abused girls in San Jose, Cebu City. These donations will serve both My Bonita Home for Girls and the rehabilitation center in Barangay Tuburan,

Cebu called the "Home of Love" for sexually trafficked girls, both managed by the religious sisters of the Mary Queen of Heaven Missionaries.



SERVE TO CHANGE LIVES

November our Club held its Basic Orientation Seminar for its aspiring members, to mold and prepare these young professionals to serve to change lives. We are very grateful to Assistant District Rotaract Representative Shevee Resolado. Rotaract Public District Image Representative JN Dagandan, our District Officers, and Rotaract Rotaract Past Presidents Marian Jabines, Jerissa Cruz and Mark Sinilong, for their inspirational talk about Rotaract and its commitment to service.

On November 26-27, Our Interact Club, Banilad Metro – Science High Cebu, together with our club, held their project series titled

"P. A. G. L. A. O. M. sa Sugbo" (or "HOPE" in Sugbo, the latter being the native name of Cebu).

The name stands for "Projects Aspiring to Give Light to All and Optimism to Many." Implemented in three (3) phases, they were able to help out many indigenous communities and achieve several areas of focus in sharing love and touching lives. Under Aksyon Proteksyon Project, donated essential medical supplies to "Life-Inspired Birthing Home" at Barangay Pit-os, Talamban and Guba Community Hospital. On the same day, our Interactors also implemented Project Papel and turned over school supplies to two elementary schools namely Mangabon and Lusaran Elementary Schools, which are remotely located in a mountain area. The following day, our Interactors and Club distributed 180 sacks of rice and school supplies to Ati Tribes and mixed-marriage families at Sitio Buyo, South Poblacion, Naga City under We Care, We Share Project. Quite remarkably, they were able to gather resources

and mobilize mostly on their own! Truly, we are very proud to have outreached together with our newlysponsored Interact Club and witness our student-leaders' self-reliance and passion for service.

With all of these reasons to celebrate, it is but regrettable that our President-Elect (PE) Emman Hernandez will be migrating to the United States. I would like to take the liberty of extending our Club's deepest gratitude to PE Emman for all his valuable help and significant contribution to RCBM.

November was indeed a busy and fulfilling month. A few members of our Club might come and go, but RCBM will continue its commitment to Serve To Change Lives.





They say 'comparison is the thief of joy'.

I know how to get along with humble means, and I also know how to live in prosperity,; in any and every circumstance I have learned the secret of being filled and going hungry, both of having abundance and suffering need. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me"


