

Here is a wrap-up of the events that occurred in RCBM for the month of February:

• On February 10, our Club had a board meeting which included the endorsement of a Rotary International Resolution against human trafficking. The resolution was approved by the Rotary International Board of Directors and our Club is very glad to be part of such a historic move.

• Our 12th General Membership Meeting last February 15 featured a feast full of fun, games, and socials for our Post-Valentines' Day, and a celebration of our Club's milestone in achieving the 100% Paul Harris Fellow Club award, which our Club celebrated with District Governor Anna Louisa Bumagat and her spouse, Past Assistant Governor Troy Bumagat, District Governor-Elect and Foundation Chair Lilu Alino, and Assistant Governor Area 1C Jensen Racho.

After much celebration, we went back to service on February 19 with the 10th Wave of OPLAN R.E.L.I.E.F. joined by our young Rotary leaders from our Rotaract Club of Banilad Metro. We, together with our Mother Club, the Rotary Club of Cebu and the Rotary Club of Mandaue East, distributed shelter kits to those whose homes were damaged or lost during the onslaught of Super Typhoon Odette at Barangay Tabunan.

• The 11th Wave of **OPLAN** R.E.L.I.E.F. followed quickly on February 20, still with our Rotaractors from the Rotaract Club of Banilad Metro, with the distribution of 1,500 relief packs to two (2) very remote mountain barangays in the City of Carcar. Many thanks to the Rotary Club of Cebu for allowing us to serve with them.

 With our passionate Rotaractors, on February 25, we proceeded with Wave 12 of OPLAN R.E.L.I.E.F. with relief operations in Barangay Lumbang in the Municipality of Dalaguete.

We, once again, deeply appreciate our Rotary partners in Luzon - The Rotary Club of Manila Magic - who helped fund our Club's relief operations. We distributed shelter kits and relief packs to groups of farmers whose houses were badly damaged by Super Typhoon Odette.

• Wave 13 quickly followed on the same day. Banilad Metro Rotarians and Rotaractors went to Barangay Coro in the same town to distribute relief packs containing rice, bottled water, canned goods, face masks, biscuits and toiletries to the fishermen's families whose boats were damaged or destroyed by the recent typhoon. Both barangays in Dalaguete (Barangays Lumbang and Coro) were kilometers away from the town proper, and reaching to these far-flung areas was quite a challenge indeed. Big thanks to the Rotary Club of Camp Aguinaldo for funding our relief efforts and making this initiative possible.

• To celebrate Rotary's Anniversary, a Rotary Day of Service

was held in the far off mountain Barangay Sudlon in Cebu City on February 26 with the distribution of shelter kits together with the Rotary Clubs of Area 1, District 3860.

 We capped off the month with a virtual fundraising through an online concert hosted by the Rotary Club of Tagum Golden LACES. which was co-hosted by our Club and the Rotary Clubs of Tagbilaran and Central Davao. Funds raised by the said event were used to buy additional shelter kits to support families who were seriously hit and lost their homes due to the recent typhoon. Our very own Membership Chair, Director Anton Mansueto, and his spouse Glynis sang a medley of songs that serenaded participants to the tune of OPM (or original Filipino music) and helped us raise the needed shelter kit funds.

As always, the Rotary Club of Banilad Metro keeps things interesting. We are so happy to be working much more closely with our young Rotary leaders from our Rotaract Club.

We are also very blessed to have partner Rotary clubs from Luzon. In exchange for these blessings is our commitment to continue sharing our love and serve to change lives.

I hope we all had a love and service-filled February 2022.




