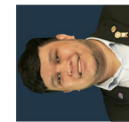

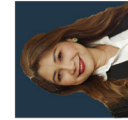

# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Greetings!

**The Life Changing Rotary Year of 2021-2022 is drawing to a close and I am happy and fulfilled, with my fellow RCBM Rotarians. It gives me great joy to say that we had an awesome year together and I am here to give you this year's last set of activities for the month of June 2022.**

On June 1, with our Rotaract Club of Banilad Metro, we hosted the "Virtual Run for A Cause – Run for Smiles 2022" as a fundraiser benefit for children with cleft lips and help them get the surgeries they need.

June 4 featured the completion of our Empowering Girls initiative that started with an informative webinar against human trafficking on May 31 and concludes with a service project. We were able to donate 500 pcs of pre-loved & high-quality clothing for the survivors of human sex trafficking at the Home of Love, a women's rehabilitation shelter, in Tuburan, Cebu.

On June 5, with Cebu Lodge 128, we had a successful surgical mission to 2 cleft lips children, 18 cyst removal surgeries & 78 circumcision at Bonbon, Cebu City followed by fellowship and social relaxation at the Lemon Tree Café in Bonbon with the Club and surgical team.

PROJECT H.O.P.E. Wave 2 also happened with the donation of suction machines and oximeters for post brain tumor surgery patients at the Vicente Sotto Memorial Center in Cebu City.

Again, on June 12, with Cebu Lodge 128, we conducted another cleft lip surgery from Toledo indigent children at Perpetual Succor Hospital. I personally assisted in the surgery of the 38th child - changing lives one smile at a time.

Before my term of office come to an end, I made sure to implement our district grant project called "Oplan Hugas Kamay – Wash". On June 18, with our Interact Club of Banilad Metro Science High Cebu, we had our Oplan Hugas Kamay – Wash 1 wherein we donated five portable wash basins for the new normal, 500 boxes of face masks, 12 gallons of alcohol for disinfection, canned goods, biscuits, hygiene kits & Uratex complementary shirts. We also conducted an educational discussion on physical distancing,

proper hand washing and dengue prevention program to beneficiary : SOS Children Village.

June 25 was the turnover of portable handwashing stations that we acquired through the District Grants we applied for from Rotary International District 3860 and The Rotary Foundation. We were joined by District 3860 Governor Anna Louisa Bumagat, District Governor Elect Lilu Alino and District Governor Nominee Designate Caroline Andrade to "Oplan Hugas Kamay – Wash 2" beneficiary : Cebu City Science National High School, the home community of our Interact Club of Banilad Metro- Science High Cebu, received five handwashing stations, ready for use.

"Oplan Hugas Kamay – Wash 3" beneficiary : Basak Community High School also received 5 washing stations, while Mandaue City Science High School received two. On

June 27, we continued turning over the other 3 wash stations we acquired from the Grant to Zapatera National High School, with

our Interactors from Science High Cebu who gave 150 soap packets and 20 gallons of rubbing alcohol.

On June 28, we held our last regular meeting that was also our Awards Night. We had the honor of having Past District Governor Philip Tan and Assistant Governor Jensen Racho joining us. In this last official meeting for the Rotary year, we acknowledged club members and partners in service who truly made this year a life-changing one. I was surprised to receive the Most Outstanding Club President in Area 1C Award from our Area 1C Assistant Governor Jensen Racho. To God be all the glory !

On June 30, with the passing of our Club Past President Angie Loja, the Club honored her posthumously and was given to her family as our sign of respect and care.

This is my last letter of update and thanks as the President of the Rotary Club of Banilad Metro. Even if I am officially stepping off that role and passing it on to President Michael Enad,

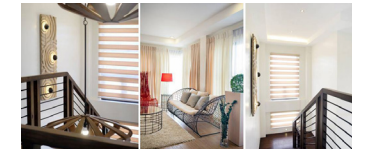

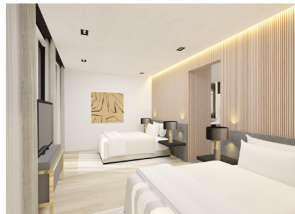

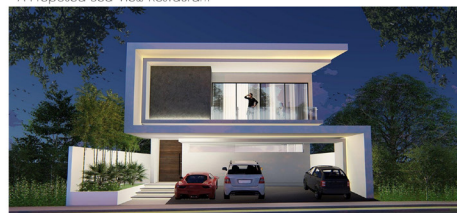
