Thank you very much DG Riz and DS Cary for the visit. And we hope to see you personally when the situation permits.



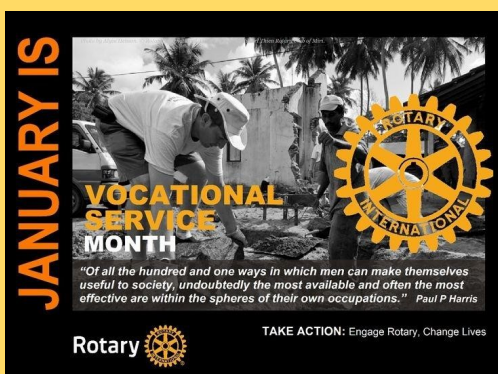
RC Calbayog Supports Vocational Service Month

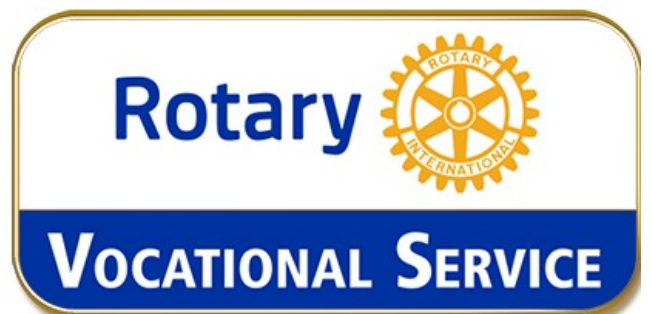
RC Calbayog Turns Over Vitamins and Other Supplements to IATF Calbayog
