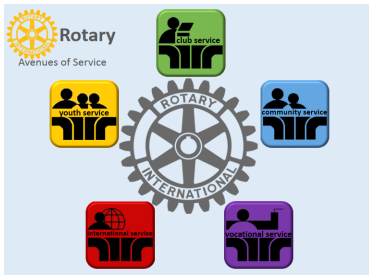
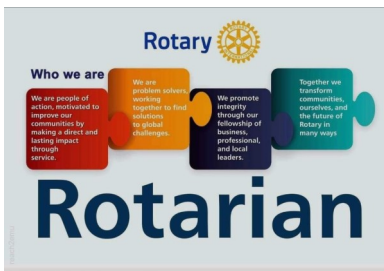


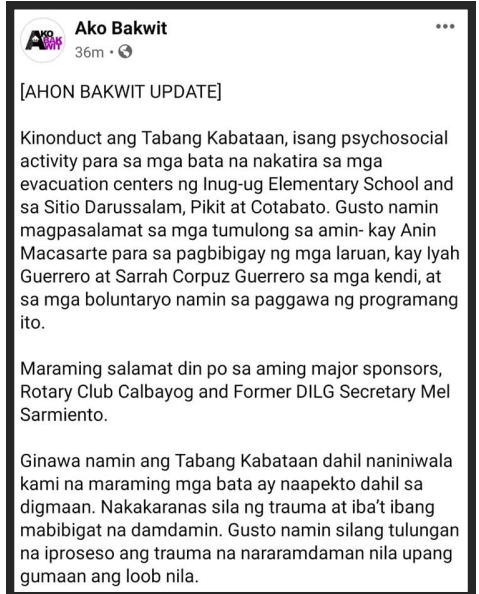
TABANG BAKWIT : A FEEDING ACTIVITY FOR THE IDP CHILDREN

The Rotary Club of Calbayog, in partnership with AkoBakwit, a Non-Governmental Organization, organized "Tabang Bakwit," Feeding Program for three hundred seventy five (375) Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) children who were victims of Marawi Siege three years ago.

The activity was held at Saguiran Shelter House, Barangay Pagalamatan in Saguiran, Lanao del Sur last August 04,2020. It was learned that many children have been living in more than a hundred shelter homes, together with their families, for three years already.

The Rotary Club of Calbayog is dedicated to supporting peace efforts and promoting peace; and to fighting sickness and diseases, which are both in line with Rotary International's Areas of Focus, to wit: Peace and Conflict Resolution/Prevention and Disease Prevention and Treatment.





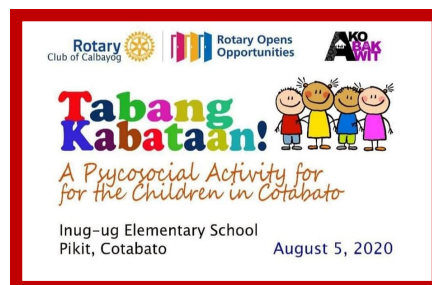
TABANG KABATAAN: A PSYCHOSOCIAL ACTIVITY FOR CHILDREN IN COTABATO

At least one hundred (100) Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) kids who are victims of RIDO (Clan Armed Conflict) were given a Psychosocial Activity in Inug-Ug Elementary School (a temporary evacuation center) in Pikit, Cotabato last August 05, 2020. The activity included COVID 19 Awareness Campaign, Feeding Program and distribution of toys.

"Tabang Kabataan," a Psychosocial Activity for children in Cotabato was made possible through the effort of the Rotary Club of Calbayog, in partnership with Ako-Bakwit, and other concerned

organizations. The Rotary Club of Calbayog believes that children in conflict areas are the most affected; and they need all the help they can get in order to overcome trauma and other psychological problems brought about by conflict or war.

The activity in Cotabato was in line with Rotary International's Areas of Focus: Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution and Disease Prevention and Treatment.

Oplan kamurayaw



With an immediate response because of the urgency of the request given the very vulnerable situation of the locals in Barangay Obo-Ob, Calbayog City, the Rotary Club of Calbayog partnered with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Calbayog, through the Mental Health Psychosocial Support Team of the City Health Office and the Philippine National Police Calbayog on its "Oplan Kamurayaw" activity last August 17, 2020.

The team provided Psychosocial First Aid (PFA) to seventy-eight (78) affected residents, both young and old, who experienced trauma and stress after a shooting incident occurred in the barangay for more than a week now. It was learned that there were several wounded innocents and a casualty recorded. The volunteer facilitators used art-based approach, storytelling and breathing exercises to foster the well-being of the participants. In addition, the participants were given the opportunity to share their experiences in a group discussion to help them manage emotions, know more their strengths and help them overcome their traumatic experience. Ultimately, envisioning on how the future will unfold and how the residents will return to their normal lives again were also part of the intervention.



RC Calbayog Holds First Club Assembly for RY Year 2020-2021
