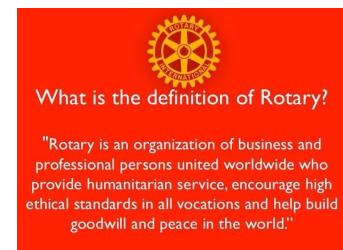
The Rotary Club of Calbayog continues to serve the community by distributing 50 food packs to concerned households in Brgy Matobato who were affected by a temporary lockdown.

- FOURTH:** The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

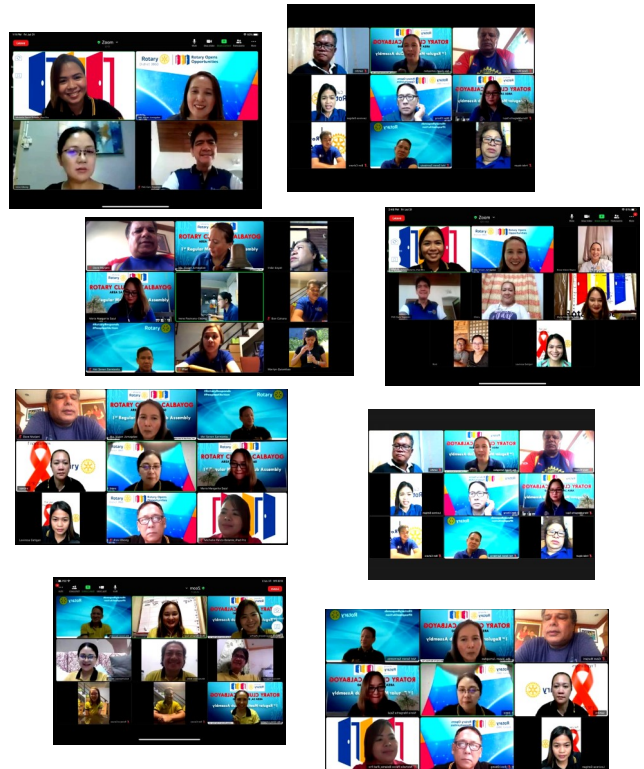
## July 2020 Club Meetings:

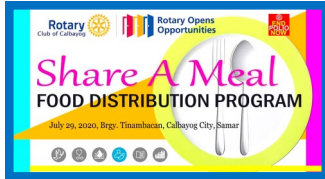
