



Rotary Club of Calbayog Holds 1st Hybrid Club Assembly for Rotary Year 2021-2022

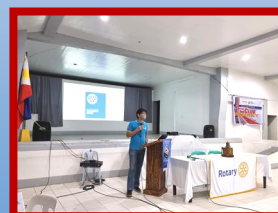
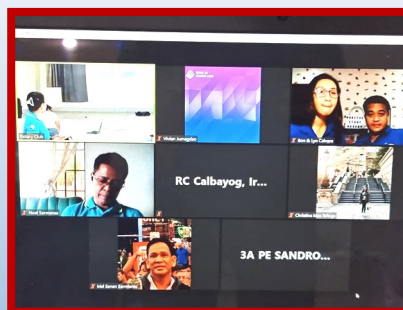

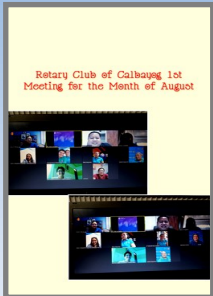

Rotary Club of Calbayog spearheads Simultaneous Bloodletting Activities

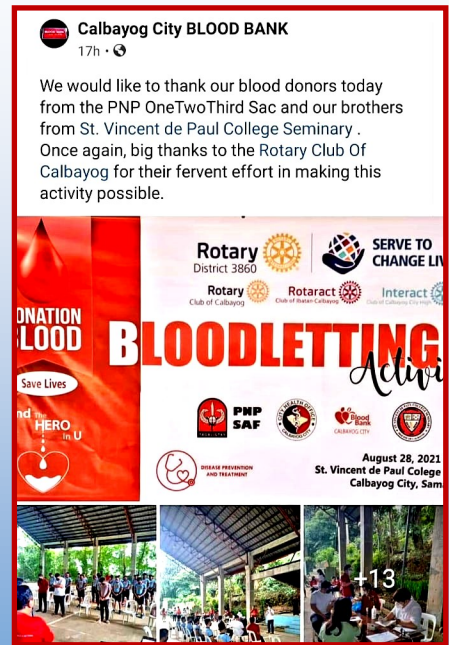
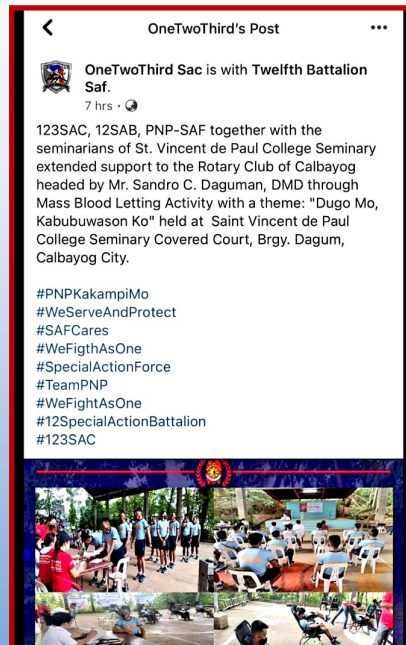
Venues: St Vincent de Paul College Seminary & Northwest Samar State University

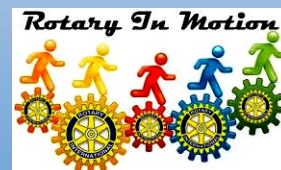

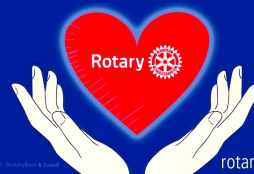
