

The Rotary Club of Calbayog believes that

children have the right to grow, survive, thrive, and fulfill their potential. But not every child is able to do so. There are still millions of children around the world whose rights are being trampled.

The Rotary Club of Calbayog, in partnership with the Commission of Human Rights, has engaged in promoting and protecting children's rights through the Child Rights Teaching and Learning for the Children or (KARAPATANG PAMBATA).

The training aimed at training children to be aware of their rights, enabling them to freely participate in the promotion and protection of these rights. Children aged 12-17 years old from marginalized families were invited so that they may be empowered not just to claim their own rights but also to empower other children in their communities to do the same.

To make the seminar interesting, group activities were interspersed with lectures. The activities helped children learned about their rights and also tackle issues relevant to them like Teen Pregnancy and Drug Addiction.

Meanwhile, President-Elect Dr Richard Alovera conducted "KARAPATANG said that it is equally important that a continuous monitoring and PAMBATA" last November support from a dedicated Non-Government Organization has to be set. Based on his observation, children enrolled in the improve academically. Children also gain self-confidence and able to speak about their rights and share their knowledge about children's rights even after the program, he added.

> The Rotary Club of Calbayog partnered with the Commission on Human Rights (CHR), Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), SOS Calbayog and selected barangays to connect with the children. And with the conclusion of the activity, it is greatly hoped that the children will gradually be able to organize themselves so that they can be the voice of other children in their barangays In this way, a more substantive level of participation may be observed from children who have become the primary claimants of their inherent, indivisible, and interdependent human rights.
