### Rotary Club of Calbayog Extends Help to a Woman Suffering from Degenerative Disease

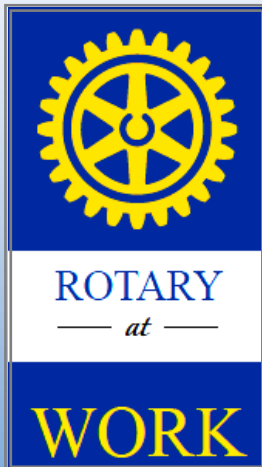
A life-changing disease such as Breast Cancer, can elicit a wide range of emotions and psychological stress. Support from family, friends and the community is needed to lessen depression, anxiety, loneliness and fear.

Breast Cancer Awareness is one of Rotary Club of Calbayog and Rotary International District 3860's advocacies. Incidentally, during the Breast Cancer Awareness Campaign, Ms. Maita Sarmiento, a teacher, informed the club that there is a 55-year-old woman suffering from this degenerative disease and is experiencing financial difficulties.



The Rotary Club of Calbayog responded immediately and paid a visit to the patient in Brgy. Lonoy, Calbayog City on November 20, 2021. The club provided financial assistance, as well as social and emotional support to the patient and her family.

In return, the patient was very thankful for the assistance extended to her by the club. "I am very much grateful to the Rotary Club of Calbayog. May you continue to be an angel to those in need," said the patient. Words that warm our hearts and inspire us to do more.

The Rotary of Calbayog conducted "KARAPATANG PAMBATA" last November 11, 2021 at Kamalig Restaurant, Brgy. Rawis, Calbayog City.

The Rotary Club of Calbayog believes that

children have the right to grow, survive, thrive, and fulfill their potential. But not every child is able to do so. There are still millions of children around the world whose rights are being trampled.

The Rotary Club of Calbayog, in partnership with the Commission of Human Rights, has engaged in promoting and protecting children's rights through the Child Rights Teaching and Learning for the Children or (KARAPATANG PAMBATA).

The training aimed at training children to be aware of their rights, enabling them to freely participate in the promotion and protection of these rights. Children aged 12-17 years old from marginalized families were invited so that they may be empowered not just to claim their own rights but also to empower other children in their communities to do the same.

To make the seminar interesting, group activities were interspersed with lectures. The activities helped children learned about their rights and also tackle issues relevant to them like Teen Pregnancy and Drug Addiction.

Meanwhile, President-Elect Dr Richard Alovera said that it is equally important that a continuous monitoring and support from a dedicated Non-Government Organization has to be set. Based on his observation, children enrolled in the program improve academically. Children also gain self-confidence and able to speak about their rights and share their knowledge about children's rights even after the program, he added.

The Rotary Club of Calbayog partnered with the Commission on Human Rights (CHR), Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), SOS Calbayog and selected barangays to connect with the children. And with the conclusion of the activity, it is greatly hoped that the children will gradually be able to organize themselves so that they can be the voice of other children in their barangays. In this way, a more substantive level of participation may be observed from children who have become the primary claimants of their inherent, indivisible, and interdependent human rights.

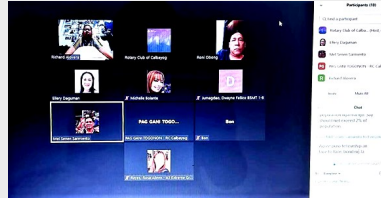
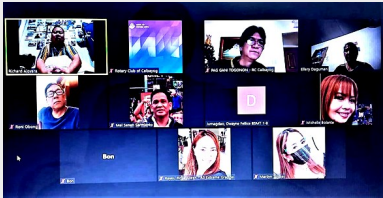

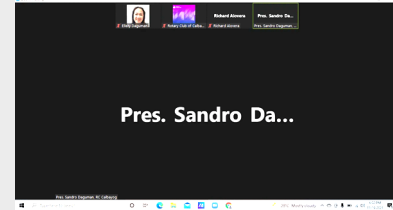
