Human schistosomiasis is also known as bilharziasis. It is a chronic water-related parasitic disease. Schistosomiasis remains an endemic parasitic disease causing much morbidity and, in some cases, mortality.

Mass drug administration (MDA) of praziquantel is the main strategy for control. To make these efforts sustainable, health education in proper handwashing and hygiene, investment in clean water supply, sanitation, and environmental and snail control need to be a part of the overall strategy. Hence the Rotary Club of Calbayog supported the Local Government of Calbayog in its strategy in eliminating this dreaded disease that is endemic in some barangay of Calbayog.


















Barangay Kilikili, Calbayog City, has been declared zero open defecation (ZOD) or open defecation free (ODF). A barangay is declared ZOD when no one in the community defecates in the open anymore. Families have learned to use a toilet for defecation and wash their hands after toilet use. "Our experience in barangay Kilikili has shown that the active involvement of communities contributed to achieving a clean, healthy, dignified, and child-friendly environment.

Through the initiative and strong conviction of the sanitary inspectors of the City Health of Calbayog and the leadership of the Barangay Captain and the support of the LGU Calbayog, and the Rotary Club of Calbayog, was able to build five new toilet facilities for those individuals who cannot afford to make their own toilet. All the people of Barangay Kilikili now have access to sanitary toilets, where they do not have to defecate in the open, in fields, and waterways where children will become more likely to experience frequent bouts of diarrhea, have worm infections and grow up stunted and undernourished

Dr. Richard Alovera III Rotary Club of Calbayog president and previous Medical Officer in the said barangay stated "It made every people in the barangay proud. They will be safer and are now safe from diarrhea and other life-threatening diseases such as Schistosomiasis. This goal of zero open defecation can be achieved if we put all our efforts together through ordinances, project implementation, performance monitoring, and aggressive goal setting,"


















Deed of Donation of 2 WASH units Agreement between Magubay Elementary School and Rotary Club of Calbayog signed.
