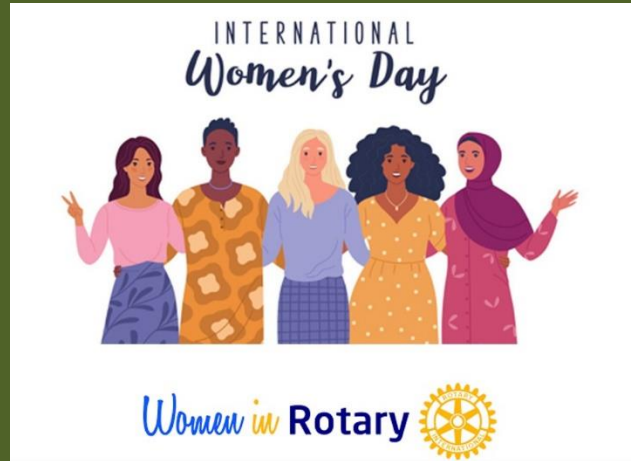


We aim to continue to provide real-world social and cultural experiences by encouraging and welcoming a geographic mix of learners on-site.
