Approximately 200 families were displaced after a fire engulfed Barangay Carmen and Obrero in Calbayog City, last April 18, 2023.










Currently, about 9 in 10 people who have cardiac arrest outside the hospital die. But CPR can help improve those odds. If it is performed in the first few minutes of cardiac arrest, CPR can double or triple a person's chance of survival. Hence awareness of this procedure in the community is very much essential.

"Sudden cardiac arrest can happen to anyone, anywhere, at any time," said Rotary Club of Calbayog PP Zandro Daguman who is also the head of the Calbayog Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office. They conducted CPR training to create awareness about handling the medical emergency in the community. More than 500 students of NwSSU participated and learn how to conduct CPR properly.


The symposium features cutting-edge speaker in the field of Child Psychiatry and an informative panel discussion, as well as collaboration with like-minded colleagues within the industry.
