Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution

Recently, the area has been cleared with New People's Army (NPA) threats based on the recent evaluation by the Philippine Army and local government units.

Our partnership with the 52nd Infantry "Agila" Battalion headed by Lieutenant Colonel Rudyard E. Garcia developed skills to strengthen peace efforts, train local leaders to prevent and mediate conflict, and support long-term peace-building in areas affected by conflict.

Disease Prevention and Treatment

Club President Richard A. Alovera III mobilized communities to help prevent the spread of major diseases such as polio, and Schistosoma that was endemic in the area. Likewise, Mental health problems of some people in the community were discussed after they have experienced trauma from previous rebel encounters.

Our Club aims in improving the capacity of local healthcare professionals, promote disease prevention programs, limit the spread of communicable diseases, and reduce the incidences of and complications from non-communicable diseases. Economic and Community Development

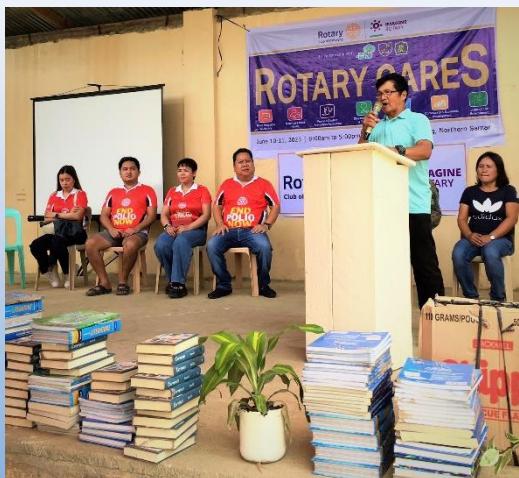


The major reason why people join rebel groups is due to poverty, lack of employment, and poor access to government services.

Water and Sanitation



The people in the community lacks access to adequate sanitation facilities. Hence one of the reasons why schistosomiasis is endemic in the area is due to improper sanitation of residents, defecating in the backyard and throwing their excreta in the rice fields which caused several residents to suffer from Schistosomiasis.

The Rotary Club of Calbayog provided basic information on how to prevent diseases. Likewise, barangay officials were also taught how to facilitate the remaining households to build their own toilet facilities, and establish a zero defecation area.
