In support of Rotary International's September theme, Basic Education and Literacy, and in line with the Rotary Club of Calbayog's commitment to promoting Adult Literacy and Peace Building and Conflict Resolution, Rotarians partnered with the Rotaract Club of Ibatan-Calbayog, the Department of Education–Calbayog Division, and the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP) for an outreach program at Calbayog City Jail for Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDL) During the visit, twenty-four (24) basic literacy learners and eighteen (18) elementary learners received slating boards and laminated films, along with notebooks and pens. Additionally, ten (10) Junior High School learners, thirteen (13) Grade 11 learners, and eight (Grade 12 learners each received notebooks and pens. All seventy-two (72) learners were also provided with basic hygiene kits. Snacks were generously sponsored by the Rotaract Club of Ibatan-Calbayog and teachers from DepEd.























Sept 01: The Rotary Club Of Calbayog convened a special meeting to plan a significant project in partnership with a private organization, scheduled for October 2025. This initiative is dedicated to supporting children in Calbayog and has the potential to benefit nearby towns and municipalities as well.
