RCCNC DISTRIBUTES 245 LITERS OF DRINKING WATER TO 'ODETTE' AFFECTED RESIDENTS IN NAGA, CEBU



Rotary District 3860, through its Rotary Club of Cebu Naga Central, distributed free potable water to families affected by TY Odette in Cabungahan, Naga, Cebu last December 31, 2021. The distribution was done in coordination with the Cabungahan Barangay Officials.

A 5-gallon container with free drinking water was distributed to each of the 85 households in the area due to lack of clean drinking water brought about by the strong typhoon. Over 500 individuals are estimated to benefit from the distribution of a total of 1,609 liters of clean and drinkable water.

Cabungahan is a mountain barangay and is around 5 kilometers away from the main highway. Its population as determined by the 2020 Census was 1,562. This represented 1.17% of the total population of Naga, Cebu.



Typhoon Rai (local name Odette) entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility on 14 December and rapidly intensified to a Category 5 typhoon, with peak winds up to 235km/hr. It made nine landfalls between 16 and 17 December in the provinces of Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte, Southern Leyte, Bohol, Cebu, Negros Oriental and Palawan. The extent of damage, though with lesser casualties, is likened to Typhoon Haiyan in 2013.
