End-Polio Awareness Campaign

On October 19, last Saturday afternoon, initiated by RCCPC, a Polio Forum was held at Tisa Elementary School with the presence of District 3860 Lilo Alino, Barangay Health officials and Barangay Officials. This was also with the strong support and initiative of our RCCPC Rotaractors. Present during the activity: yours truly, VP Boboy Tan, Auditor/PP Rey Sabay, Dir. Robert Barquilla, and PAG/PP Boy Unabia. With us also were five (5) RCCPC Rotaractors headed by Minnie Labang. Thank you!

On October 20, last Sunday @ 5am, initiated by RC Cebu, "Walk To End Polio Now" was held with a route from Fuente Osmeña to Colon Street and back to Fuente Osmeña. A joint breakfast inside Fuente Osmeña Circle/Oval was done each club. Present during the activity: yours truly, Auditor/PP Rey Sabay, PDG Ted Locson, and our five (5) RCCPC Rotaractors with led by Minnie Labang. Thank you!

After our "Walk To End Polio Now" on the same Sunday at 9am, initiated by Phil. Dental Association – Cebu Chapter and partnered with RCCPC, there was a Turn-over of Wash Area at Camp Bagooboc Elementary School and Tree Planting at Barangay Sunog Elementary School (at the foot of Mt. Manunggal, Balamban,Cebu). I would like to thank PAG Felix Asoy for representing our Club after I was unable to reach at the site. My motorbike got engine trouble somewhere Pung-ol Sibugay's steep uphill area. I was rescued by my motorcycle group and went back to Cebu City for engine repair.

This Monday morning, October 21 @ 10am, Golden Prince Hotel, initiated by Dist. 3860 - Area One, a Media Conference was held with the presence of Cebu tri-media reporters for the prime purpose of having a Polio awareness campaign in our area of concern.

An Dist. 3860 - Area One, "Patak" Immunization Day is organized this Wednesday, 23 October 2019, with our Club assigned at Tejero Health Center. Gathering area and time is at DOH Region 7 parking area (Osmeña Boulevard) at 7:00 in the morning. We encourage everyone to participate and support our District.

By Nov. 22-23, 2019, there is a "Ride to End Polio" organized by RC Cebu. As shared by 'Polio Plus' Coordinator Bernard Vonn Sia, forty (40) cyclists will do a round Cebu 550-km ride and there will be designated stops for the group to join mass vaccination with Town health centers. For RCCPC, we are looking at San Remigio as our assigned town. After there, we can proceed to Bogo town, the last stop of 40 cyclists, and join the mass vaccination before proceeding to Cebu City.

For these activities, we are required by the District to wear the Official End Polio Rotary Shirt. So, to those who already ordered shirts, please claim it tonight. I am encouraging each RCCPC Rotarians to join us for above activities, not to mention that we can credit it under our Club's Area of Focus project/s if our numbers can reach at least five (5) participants.

Furthermore, we will likewise discuss tonight about our Cebu Rotaplast Mission pending items (e.g. financial report) and our TRF pledges/commitments to the District.

1) END POLIO SHIRT - RY2019-2020 edition

1.1 Rationale: The “Immunization Saves Lives” End Polio Shirt is an awareness and fundraising campaign as we commemorate 40 years of the first polio vaccination in 1979 in the Philippines. A cost component of the shirt goes to Polio Plus under the name of the club. The shirt will first be worn this month of October to celebrate district-initiated events to celebrate World Polio Day and other End Polio Now activities initiated by the clubs.

1.2 How to Order: First, determine the sizes of club members who would like to acquire the shirt. Second, pay the cost of P550.00 per shirt multiply by the number of shirts ordered. 5) RIDE TO END POLIO: November 22 - 24, 2019

Project Champion: Polio Plus Coordinator/PP Bernard Vonn Sia

- 5.1 Forty (40) Cyclists will do a round Cebu 550 Km ride, dubbed as “the longest ride”. Route: from Capitol to South of Cebu to North of Cebu back to Cebu City. As of Oct. 8, there are already 23 cyclists who confirmed participation.
- 5.2 At designated stops, Team will visit health centers for mass vaccination (to be coordinated with DOH)
- 5.3 Ride to End Polio will end at Fort San Pedro; program will be held with DG Philip Tan, Cebu Province/Cebu City officials to give messages. (Invitations to be worked on)
- 5.4 Project will be documented through video for public image purposes; story article to be shared in GML, PRM and local news. Press conference will be conducted this October 24.
- 5.5 Funds raised through personal and club pledges will be for the Polio Fund and credited to the respective Clubs.
- 5.6 Emergency and safety measures are carefully planned for this project.

2019-2020 ROTARY CITATION FOR ROTARY CLUBS

The **Rotary Citation** recognizes Rotary clubs that support our strategic priorities by completing certain activities. Clubs have the entire Rotary year to achieve the citation's goals.

Rotary can automatically verify many of your club's achievements as long as you keep your club and member information up-to-date in My Rotary. To be eligible for the Rotary Citation, clubs need to begin the year as active clubs that are in good standing and remain so throughout the year. Achievements will be compared with membership figures from 1 July 2019 and will be recognized after the 1 July 2020 numbers are final, on 15 August 2020.

UNITE PEOPLE

Achieve at least 5 of the following goals:

- Appoint an active club membership committee comprised of no less than five members and report the chair to Rotary International
- Achieve a net gain in membership
- Maintain or improve your club's retention of current and new members:
 - Improve your club's retention rate by 1 percentage point **or**
 - If your club's retention rate was 90 percent or more in 2018-2019, maintain it
- Achieve a net gain in female members or members under the age of 40
- Conduct a study of your members' occupations, and work to align your membership with the mix of businesses and professions in your community
- Sponsor or co-sponsor a new Rotary club or Rotary Community Corps
- Sponsor or co-sponsor an Interact or Rotaract club
- Host an event for Rotary alumni, and highlight Rotary's networking opportunities
- Sponsor a Youth Exchange student or RYLA participant

TAKE ACTION

2019-2020 ROTARY CITATION FOR ROTARACT CLUBS

The **Rotary Citation for Rotaract Clubs** recognizes clubs that support our strategic priorities by completing certain activities. Clubs have the entire Rotary year to achieve the citation's goals.

To be eligible for the Rotary Citation, Rotaract clubs need to be certified by Rotary International and endorsed by the district governor before 1 July 2019. Clubs will report their achievements by submitting a nomination form by 15 August 2020.

UNITE PEOPLE

Achieve at least 3 of the following goals:

- Achieve a net gain of one member
- Have at least 50 percent of members add their skills and interests in their profiles on My Rotary
- Establish or maintain a twin club relationship
- Host an activity or event during World Rotaract Week (the anniversary of Rotaract); invite the media and tell your club's, and Rotary's, story
- Participate in a networking event or social activity with your sponsor Rotary club

TAKE ACTION

Achieve at least 3 of the following goals:

- Achieve an average minimum PolioPlus contribution of \$25 per member
- Hold an event to raise funds for, or to increase awareness of, Rotary's work toward polio eradication
- Partner with your sponsor Rotary club on a significant local or international service project in one of Rotary's six areas of focus
- Post successful club projects, with details about activities, volunteer hours, and funds raised, on Rotary.org

THE BRIEF HISTORY OF ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER



In the beginning were five men and one vision...

In a historic series of preparative meetings in May 1985, Felipe Casing, Antonio Elumir, Manny Granada, Jacinto Jamero and Rey Sanggalang envisioned the Port Center of Cebu as a vantage ground from where a band of noble men shall rise by the name of Rotary, in a game of service to humanity.

What followed was a marathon dash in establishing a Rotary Club in the Cebu Port District to obtain a charter from then District 3860 Governor Jose "Joe" Lardizabal whose term was to conclude very soon. On the forefront was Pepe Casing, a Cebu Fuente Rotarian.

It was in the special day of June 6, 1985 when a charter was granted to a club that was christened a most befitting name: The "ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER".

The newfound organization that was once a nucleus of five visionaries became a club of 34 gentlemen who convened charter members in the middle of June 1985 to bear witness to the first set of officers. Antonio "Jun" Elumir, who was then the Phil. Ports Authority Officer, was the Charter President. With him at the helm was Manuel "Manny" Granada, the charter vice-president, Jacinto "Boy" Jamero and "Rey" Sanggalang were the charter secretary and charter treasurer, respectively. These gentlemen who were the prime movers for the organization of our club were equally accorded those distinct and rare positions which can only happen once in a history of a club.

Pepe Casing was honored with the venerable title of "Godfather".

The pioneering charter members, most of who are still with the RCCPC, instilled the club's love for sports – golf, bowling and tennis – in that order of popularity among its members. An incessant talk about these sports keeps alive the fellowship that follows its weekly meeting every Monday evening. Do not be surprised if you hear other people mistakenly refer to RCCPC as the Rotary Club of Cebu "Sports Center".

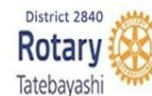
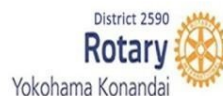
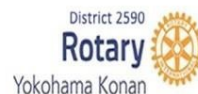
