

Things discussed – among others – include Hosting Assignment of ACOM (Area 1B will be this coming April 4, 2020), Registration to DISCON 2020, TRF Night, Interact Boot Camp, and DTTS/PETS/SETS. On behalf of our Club, I supported and committed attendees for the 8th Interact Bootcamp this Feb. 29 to Mar 1, 2020 @ Alta Cebu Resorts, Pilipog, Mactan and our Club will send delegates to the activity. Registration is Feb. 21, 2020 at Php2,300 for students and Php2,200 for Interact Advisers. Cost is inclusive of accommodations, food, seminar kit, certificates, and a dri-fit shirt.

District Conference 2020

As relayed during our last week's Rotary meeting, our District Conference (DisCon) 2020 is held this March 5-7, 2020 at Cebu Grand Convention Center, Banilad, Cebu City. Let us all participate this activity and join our Cebuano District Governor in welcoming delegates from our District 3860. DisCon is open for Rotarian spouses and Rotaractors.

Promo registration cost (with deadline until January 31, 2020) is Php4,500.00 for Rotarian (Php3,000.00 for Spouse and Rotaractor). After January 31, cost is raised to Php6,000.00. Club listing is at Php3,500.00 per club. Guide for "DISCON 2020 Registration How-To" (and different ways to register) and "DisCon 2020 – Incentive Scheme" is enclosed in our Portside today's issue.



As our Club is tasked to host the Golf and Bowling tournaments on March 4, 2020, we have finalized and officially declare IPP Rodien Paca to chair for the Golf Tournament and PP Sam Tiu (to be assisted by Rot. Roland Bantilan) for the Bowling Tournament, respectively.

2019-2020 ROTARY CITATION FOR ROTARY CLUBS

The **Rotary Citation** recognizes Rotary clubs that support our strategic priorities by completing certain activities. Clubs have the entire Rotary year to achieve the citation's goals.

Rotary can automatically verify many of your club's achievements as long as you keep your club and member information up-to-date in My Rotary. To be eligible for the Rotary Citation, clubs need to begin the year as active clubs that are in good standing and remain so throughout the year. Achievements will be compared with membership figures from 1 July 2019 and will be recognized after the 1 July 2020 numbers are final, on 15 August 2020.

UNITE PEOPLE

Achieve at least 5 of the following goals:

- Appoint an active club membership committee comprised of no less than five members and report the chair to Rotary International
- Achieve a net gain in membership
- Maintain or improve your club's retention of current and new members:
 - O Improve your club's retention rate by 1 percentage point or
 - If your club's retention rate was 90 percent or more in 2018-2019, maintain it
- Achieve a net gain in female members or members under the age of 40
- Conduct a study of your members' occupations, and work to align your membership with the mix of businesses and professions in your community
- Sponsor or co-sponsor a new Rotary club or Rotary Community Corps
- Sponsor or co-sponsor an Interact or Rotaract club
- Host an event for Rotary alumni, and highlight Rotary's networking opportunities
- Sponsor a Youth Exchange student or RYLA participant

TAKE ACTION

2019-2020 ROTARY CITATION FOR ROTARACT CLUBS

The Rotary Citation for Rotaract Clubs recognizes clubs that support our strategic priorities by completing certain activities. Clubs have the entire Rotary year to achieve the citation's goals.

To be eligible for the Rotary Citation, Rotaract clubs need to be certified by Rotary International and endorsed by the district governor before 1 July 2019. Clubs will report their achievements by submitting a nomination form by 15 August 2020.

UNITE PEOPLE

Achieve at least 3 of the following goals:

- · Achieve a net gain of one member
- Have at least 50 percent of members add their skills and interests in their profiles on My Rotary
- Establish or maintain a twin club relationship

- Participate in a networking event or social activity with your sponsor Rotary club

THE BRIEF HISTORY OF ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER



In the beginning were five men and one vision...

In a historic series of preparative meetings in May 1985, Felipe Casing, Antonio Elumir, Manny Granada, Jacinto Jamero and Rey Sanggalang envisioned the Port Center of Cebu as a vantage ground from where a band of noble men shall rise by the name of Rotary, in a game of service to humanity.

What followed was a marathon dash in establishing a Rotary Club in the Cebu Port District to obtain a charter from then District 3860 Governor Jose "Joe" Lardizabal whose term was to conclude very soon. On the forefront was Pepe Casing, a Cebu Fuente Rotarian.

It was in the special day of June 6, 1985 when a charter was granted to a club that was christened a most befitting name: The "ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER".

The newfound organization that was once a nucleus of five visionaries became a club of 34 gentlemen who convened charter members in the middle of June 1985 to bear witness to the first set of officers. Antonio "Jun" Elumir, who was then the Phil. Ports Authority Officer, was the Charter President. With him at the helm was Manuel "Manny" Granada, the charter vice-president, Jacinto "Boy" Jamero and "Rey" Sanggalang were the charter secretary and charter treasurer, respectively. These gentlemen who were the prime movers for the organization of our club were equally accorded those distinct and rare positions which can only happen once in a history of a club.

Pepe Casing was honored with the venerable title of "Godfather". The pioneering charter members, most of who are still with the RCCPC, instilled the club's love for sports – golf, bowling and tennis – in that order of popularity among its members. An incessant talk about these sports keeps alive the fellowship that follows its weekly meeting every Monday evening. Do not be surprised if you hear other people mistakenly refer to RCCPC as the Rotary Club of Cebu "Sports Center".




