





President's Message – February 2020

Today in 1863, a royal decree establishes San Francisco, in Camotes Island, a parish. Also, today in 1897, Governor of Cebu Celestino Fernandez Tejero y Molet resigns from his post to assume the position of General of the Spanish Division in Northern Luzon. Lastly, today in 1899, a group of Cebu women sends a petition to General Emilio Aguinaldo asking that Spanish bishop Martin Alcocer,

who had fled Cebu after the revolutionary takeover, be allowed to remain in his post in Cebu.

Rotary is where neighbors, friends, and problem-solvers share ideas, join leaders, and take action to create lasting change!

Welcome everyone for tonight's meeting!

We have lot of things to discuss and I really appreciate your presence despite the not so good news about a man inside our country died from the Wuhan coronavirus – the first time a death has been reported outside mainland China since the outbreak began in December.

First and foremost, my appreciation to the following persons who attended our Area 1 Coordination Meeting last Saturday at Casino Espanol de Cebu hosted by Area 1E: DICO Jeff Tan, IPP Rodien Paca, and PP Rey Sabay. I was in Makati City for a business trip last week and the reason for my inability to join the said meeting.

Wuhan Coronavirus

The coronavirus outbreak has killed at least **305 people** and infected more than **14,300** globally, as it continues to <u>spread beyond China</u>. The virus has been confirmed in more than 25 countries and territories since it was first detected in the Chinese city of <u>Wuhan</u> in December. Countries are now sending planes to evacuate their citizens from the infection zone, and imposing travel bans or restrictions on mainland China. Nearly 60 million people are under lockdown in Chinese cities as international researchers race to develop a vaccine and halt its spread.

As Rotarian, we knew that it is our challenge to join other 1.2 million colleagues, neighbors, friends, leaders, and problem-solvers - who see a world where people unit and take action to create lasting change – across the globe, in our communities, and in ourselves.



In our challenge today, I also believe good health care is everyone's right. That is why treating and preventing disease is so important to each of us. Rotary International has already combating diseases like malaria, HIV/AIDS, Alzheimer's, multiple sclerosis, diabetes, and polio. Wuhan coronavirus is another challenge for Rotary especially to our place. As prevention is important, we will now focus on health education and proper information dissemination. We will talk and give time on this issue tonight and learn more about this disease.

District Conference 2020

Our District Conference (DisCon) 2020 is already fast-approaching and the "promo" low DisCon cost already ended last January 31, 2020.

Our 2020 DisCon is held this coming March 5 – 7, 2020 (Thur to Sat) at Cebu Grand Convention Center, Banilad, Cebu City. Registration is now back to its regular rate at Php6,000.00. You may deposit your payment to BPI Account No. 9121-0074-84 (Robinsons Galleria), RC CEBU WEST ROTARIANS INC. Once done, please write your name on the deposit slip and send it to our Club Secretary (Jensen), Club Treasurer (John) or our Club Clerk (Sharich).

As already mentioned from our last Portside Bulletin issues, our Club is given the responsibility to host the Golf and Bowling tournaments on March 4, 2020 (a day before the actual DisCon day).

For the Golf Tournament ("Paul Harris Cup"), IPP Rodien already finalized the venue at Cebu Country Club and registration is set at Php4,000 per player (cost inclusive of shared cart, green fees, giveaways, dinner and raffles). There is a prize for Hole-In-One sponsored by Phil. Span Asia Carrier Corp.

For the Bowling Tournament (same day of the Golf Tournament), since there are only two teams competing each other – the Visayas and Mindanao, each team will be composed of ten (10) players. The tournament will be held at SM Cebu, at 6:00 PM. Tentative registration cost is Php1,000 per player. Winner is based on the total highest score for a team. So, this is a showdown between Visayas against Mindanao Rotarian bowlers. The Bowling Committee (c/o PP Sam Tiu and PP Rey Sabay) will give more updates within the week especially the guidelines and mechanics of the tournament.

The **Rotary Citation** recognizes Rotary clubs that support our strategic priorities by completing certain activities. Clubs have the entire Rotary year to achieve the citation's goals.

Rotary can automatically verify many of your club's achievements as long as you keep your club and member information up-to-date in My Rotary. To be eligible for the Rotary Citation, clubs need to begin the year as active clubs that are in good standing and remain so throughout the year. Achievements will be compared with membership figures from 1 July 2019 and will be recognized after the 1 July 2020 numbers are final, on 15 August 2020.

UNITE PEOPLE

Achieve at least 5 of the following goals:

- Appoint an active club membership committee comprised of no less than five members and report the chair to Rotary International
- Achieve a net gain in membership
- Maintain or improve your club's retention of current and new members:
 - O Improve your club's retention rate by 1 percentage point or
 - If your club's retention rate was 90 percent or more in 2018-2019, maintain it
- Achieve a net gain in female members or members under the age of 40
- Conduct a study of your members' occupations, and work to align your membership with the mix of businesses and professions in your community
- Sponsor or co-sponsor a new Rotary club or Rotary Community Corps
- Sponsor or co-sponsor an Interact or Rotaract club
- Host an event for Rotary alumni, and highlight Rotary's networking opportunities
- Sponsor a Youth Exchange student or RYLA participant

To be eligible for the Rotary Citation, Rotaract clubs need to be certified by Rotary International and endorsed by the district governor before 1 July 2019. Clubs will report their achievements by submitting a nomination form by 15 August 2020.

THE BRIEF HISTORY OF ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER



In the beginning were five men and one vision... In a historic series of preparative meetings in May 1985, Felipe Casing, Antonio Elumir, Manny Granada, Jacinto Jamero and Rey Sanggalang envisioned the Port Center of Cebu as a vantage ground from where a band of noble men shall rise by the name of Rotary, in a game of service to humanity.

What followed was a marathon dash in establishing a Rotary Club in the Cebu Port District to obtain a charter from then District 3860 Governor Jose "Joe" Lardizabal whose term was to conclude very soon. On the forefront was Pepe Casing, a Cebu Fuente Rotarian.

It was in the special day of June 6, 1985 when a charter was granted to a club that was christened a most befitting name: The "ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER".

The newfound organization that was once a nucleus of five visionaries became a club of 34 gentlemen who convened charter members in the middle of June 1985 to bear witness to the first set of officers. Antonio "Jun" Elumir, who was then the Phil. Ports Authority Officer, was the Charter President. With him at the helm was Manuel "Manny" Granada, the charter vice-president, Jacinto "Boy" Jamero and "Rey" Sanggalang were the charter secretary and charter treasurer, respectively. These gentlemen who were the prime movers for the organization of our club were equally accorded those distinct and rare positions which can only happen once in a history of a club.

Pepe Casing was honored with the venerable title of "Godfather". The pioneering charter members, most of who are still with the RCCPC, instilled the club's love for sports – golf, bowling and tennis – in that order of popularity among its members. An incessant talk about these sports keeps alive the fellowship that follows its weekly meeting every Monday evening. Do not be surprised if you hear other people mistakenly refer to RCCPC as the Rotary Club of Cebu "Sports Center".
