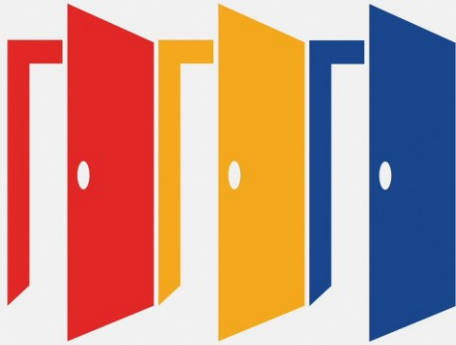

He added that Rotary creates leadership opportunities and gives members the chance to travel the world to put their service ideas into action and make lifelong connections. “Everything we do opens another opportunity for someone, somewhere,” said Knaack.

Knaack also wants to see more women in leadership roles and see Rotaractors play an integral role in how new clubs are formed and run. He encouraged district leaders to create new club models and rethink what it means to be in Rotary, and allow young people to be the architects of these new clubs.

## **ROTARY WEEK (LAUNCHING)**

On February 23, 1905 at Unity Building, Chicago, Illinois, USA, Rotary started with the vision of one man – Paul Harris. The Chicago attorney established the Rotary Club of Chicago so professionals with diverse backgrounds could exchange ideas and form meaningful, lifelong friendships.

To commemorate its establishment, Rotary Area One together with our District Governor and Rotary Week Chairman, IPP Rodien Paca, gathered on February 23, 2020 (a Sunday). Area One Rotarians celebrated the day with a Holy Mass at Capitol Parish at 11:00 in the morning and followed by lunch with short program at Cebu Grand Hotel at 12:00 noon to 2:00 in the afternoon. That day was a commencement embarking on Family of Rotary Fellowship (Foundation Day), Club Service Activity, and “Let’s Intensify Our Community Service!” (February 23-29, 2020).

I thanked the presence and support of IPP Rodien Paca, the Rotary Week Chairman, with his spouse & children, and PAG/PP Boy Unabia and his wife.

## **Situation Reports/Update: Novel Coronavirus**

As previously mentioned in our last Portside Bulletin issue, we need to be updated as Rotarian and share correct information to our colleagues and countrymen.

World Health Organization (W.H.O.) updates and highlights as of 29 February 2020 are as follows:

Two new Member States (Mexico and San Marino) reported cases of COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.

WHO has published the *Rational use of personal protective equipment for COVID-19*. This document summarizes WHO recommendations for the appropriate use of personal protective equipment (PPE) in health care and community settings, including the handling of cargo. More information on Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) activities can be found in the Subject in Focus.

Globally there are already 85,403 confirmed (1,753 new). China – 75,394 confirmed (435 new), 2,838 deaths (47 new). Outside of China – 6,009 confirmed (1,318 new), 53 countries (2 new), 86 deaths (19 new).



## W.H.O. RECOMMENDATIONS AND ADVICE FOR THE PUBLIC:

If you are not in an area where COVID-19 is spreading, or have not travelled from an area where COVID-19 is spreading, or have not been in contact with an infected patient, your risk of infection is low. It is understandable that you may feel anxious about the outbreak. It's a good idea to get the facts from reliable sources to help you accurately determine your risks so that you can take reasonable precautions (See Frequently Asked Questions <https://www.who.int/news-room/q-a-detail/q-a-coronaviruses>). Seek guidance from WHO, your healthcare provider, your national public health authority or your employer for accurate information on COVID-19 and whether COVID-19 is circulating where you live. It is important to be informed of the situation and take appropriate measures to protect yourself and your family (see Protection measures for everyone <https://www.who.int/emergencies/diseases/novel-coronavirus-2019/advice-for-public>).

If you are in an area where there are cases of COVID-19 you need to take the risk of infection seriously. Follow the advice of WHO and guidance issued by national and local health authorities. For most people, COVID-19 infection will cause mild illness however, it can make some people very ill and in some people, it can be fatal. Older people, and those with pre-existing medical conditions (such as cardiovascular disease, chronic respiratory disease or diabetes) are at risk for severe disease (See Protection measures for persons who are in or have recently visited (past 14 days) areas where COVID-19 is spreading.

Per W.H.O. Surveillance, reports on per table are found at the bottom of this column/article.

\*Case classifications are based on [WHO case definitions](#) for COVID-19.

†Transmission classification is based on WHO analysis of available official data and may be subject to reclassification as additional data become available. Countries/territories/areas experiencing multiple types of transmission are classified in the highest category for which there is evidence; they may be removed from a given category if interruption of transmission can be demonstrated. It should be noted that even within categories, different countries/territories/areas may have differing degrees of transmission as indicated by the differing numbers of cases and other factors. Not all locations within a given country/territory/area are equally affected.

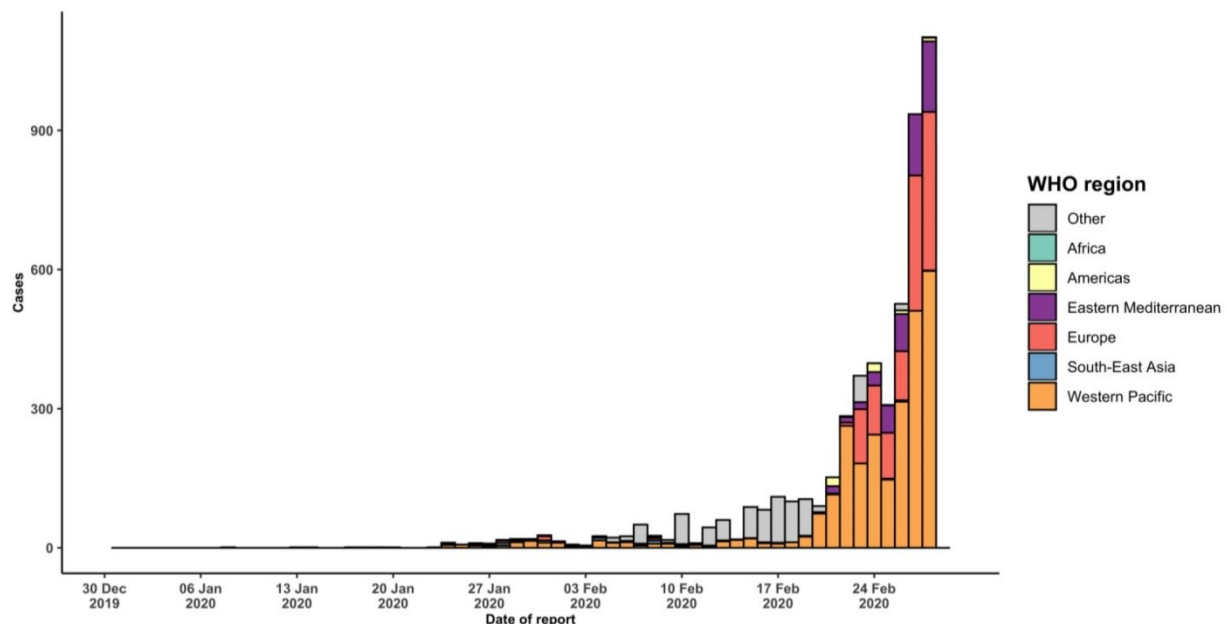
Terms:

- **Community transmission** is evidenced by the inability to relate confirmed cases through chains of transmission for a large number of cases, or by increasing positive tests through routine screening of sentinel samples.
- **Local transmission** indicates locations where the source of infection is within the reporting location.
- **Imported cases only** indicates locations where all cases have been acquired outside the location of reporting.
- **Under investigation** indicates locations where type of transmission has not been determined for any cases.
- **Interrupted transmission** indicates locations where interruption of transmission has been demonstrated (details to be determined)

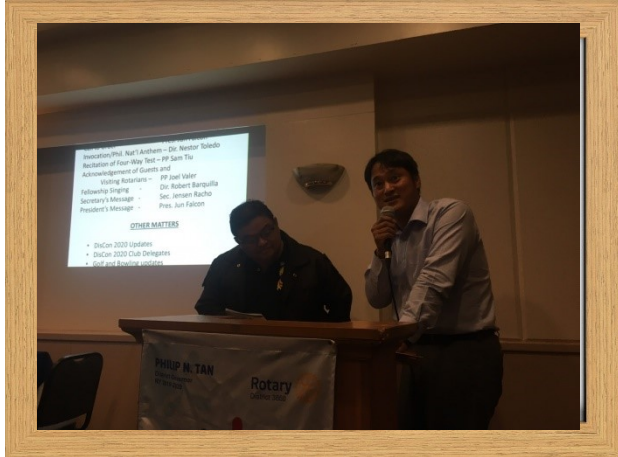

## 2019-2020 ROTARY CITATION FOR ROTARY CLUBS

The **Rotary Citation** recognizes Rotary clubs that support our strategic priorities by completing certain activities. Clubs have the entire Rotary year to achieve the citation's goals.

Rotary can automatically verify many of your club's achievements as long as you keep your club and member information up-to-date in My Rotary. To be eligible for the Rotary Citation, clubs need to begin the year as active clubs that are in good standing and remain so throughout the year. Achievements will be compared with membership figures from 1 July 2019 and will be recognized after the 1 July 2020 numbers are final, on 15 August 2020.

### UNITE PEOPLE

Achieve at least 5 of the following goals:

- Appoint an active club membership committee comprised of no less than five members and report the chair to Rotary International
- Achieve a net gain in membership
- Maintain or improve your club's retention of current and new members:
  - Improve your club's retention rate by 1 percentage point **or**
  - If your club's retention rate was 90 percent or more in 2018-2019, maintain it
- Achieve a net gain in female members or members under the age of 40
- Conduct a study of your members' occupations, and work to align your membership with the mix of businesses and professions in your community
- Sponsor or co-sponsor a new Rotary club or Rotary Community Corps
- Sponsor or co-sponsor an Interact or Rotaract club
- Host an event for Rotary alumni, and highlight Rotary's networking opportunities
- Sponsor a Youth Exchange student or RYLA participant

### TAKE ACTION

Achieve at least 5 of the following goals:

- Appoint an active club Foundation committee comprised of no less than five members and report the chair to Rotary International
- Increase the number of members involved in service projects
- Contribute at least \$100 per capita to the Annual Fund of The Rotary Foundation

- Arrange for the club's members to talk with the media to tell your club's and Rotary's story

## 2019-2020 ROTARY CITATION FOR ROTARACT CLUBS

The **Rotary Citation for Rotaract Clubs** recognizes clubs that support our strategic priorities by completing certain activities. Clubs have the entire Rotary year to achieve the citation's goals.

To be eligible for the Rotary Citation, Rotaract clubs need to be certified by Rotary International and endorsed by the district governor before 1 July 2019. Clubs will report their achievements by submitting a nomination form by 15 August 2020.

### UNITE PEOPLE

Achieve at least 3 of the following goals:

- Achieve a net gain of one member
- Have at least 50 percent of members add their skills and interests in their profiles on My Rotary
- Establish or maintain a twin club relationship
- Host an activity or event during World Rotaract Week (the anniversary of Rotaract); invite the media and tell your club's, and Rotary's, story
- Participate in a networking event or social activity with your sponsor Rotary club

### TAKE ACTION

Achieve at least 3 of the following goals:

- Achieve an average minimum PolioPlus contribution of \$25 per member

## THE BRIEF HISTORY OF ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER



In the beginning were five men and one vision...

In a historic series of preparative meetings in May 1985, Felipe Casing, Antonio Elumir, Manny Granada, Jacinto Jamero and Rey Sanggalang envisioned the Port Center of Cebu as a vantage ground from where a band of noble men shall rise by the name of Rotary, in a game of service to humanity.

What followed was a marathon dash in establishing a Rotary Club in the Cebu Port District to obtain a charter from then District 3860 Governor Jose "Joe" Lardizabal whose term was to conclude very soon. On the forefront was Pepe Casing, a Cebu Fuente Rotarian.

It was in the special day of June 6, 1985 when a charter was granted to a club that was christened a most befitting name: The "ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER".

The newfound organization that was once a nucleus of five visionaries became a club of 34 gentlemen who convened charter members in the middle of June 1985 to bear witness to the first set of officers. Antonio "Jun" Elumir, who was then the Phil. Ports Authority Officer, was the Charter President. With him at the helm was Manuel "Manny" Granada, the charter vice-president, Jacinto "Boy" Jamero and "Rey" Sanggalang were the charter secretary and charter treasurer, respectively. These gentlemen who were the prime movers for the organization of our club were equally accorded those distinct and rare positions which can only happen once in a history of a club.

Pepe Casing was honored with the venerable title of "Godfather".

The pioneering charter members, most of who are still with the RCCPC, instilled the club's love for sports – golf, bowling and tennis – in that order of popularity among its members. An incessant talk about these sports keeps alive the fellowship that follows its weekly meeting every Monday evening. Do not be surprised if you hear other people mistakenly refer to RCCPC as the Rotary Club of Cebu "Sports Center".

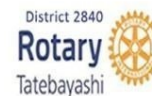
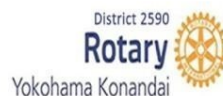
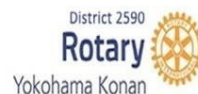
