Today in the history of Cebu, "On July 20, 1903, a cholera epidemic breaks out in Cebu. From this day until May 31, 1904, Cebu registered 19,923 deaths in a population of 667, 057, making for an average of 30 per 1000 people."

Last Friday, July 17, 2020, we had successfully delivered to the beneficiaries of our first Club Project which was the donation of PPE uniforms, Surgical Face Masks and Alcohols to the Cebu City Medical Center (CCMC) and the Vicente Sotto Memorial Medical Center (VSMMMC).

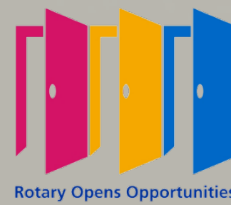

In closing, Walt Disney said, "All our dreams can come true, if we have the courage to pursue them."

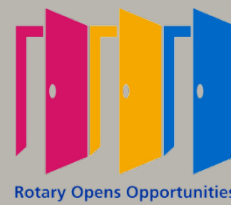

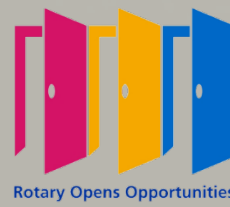

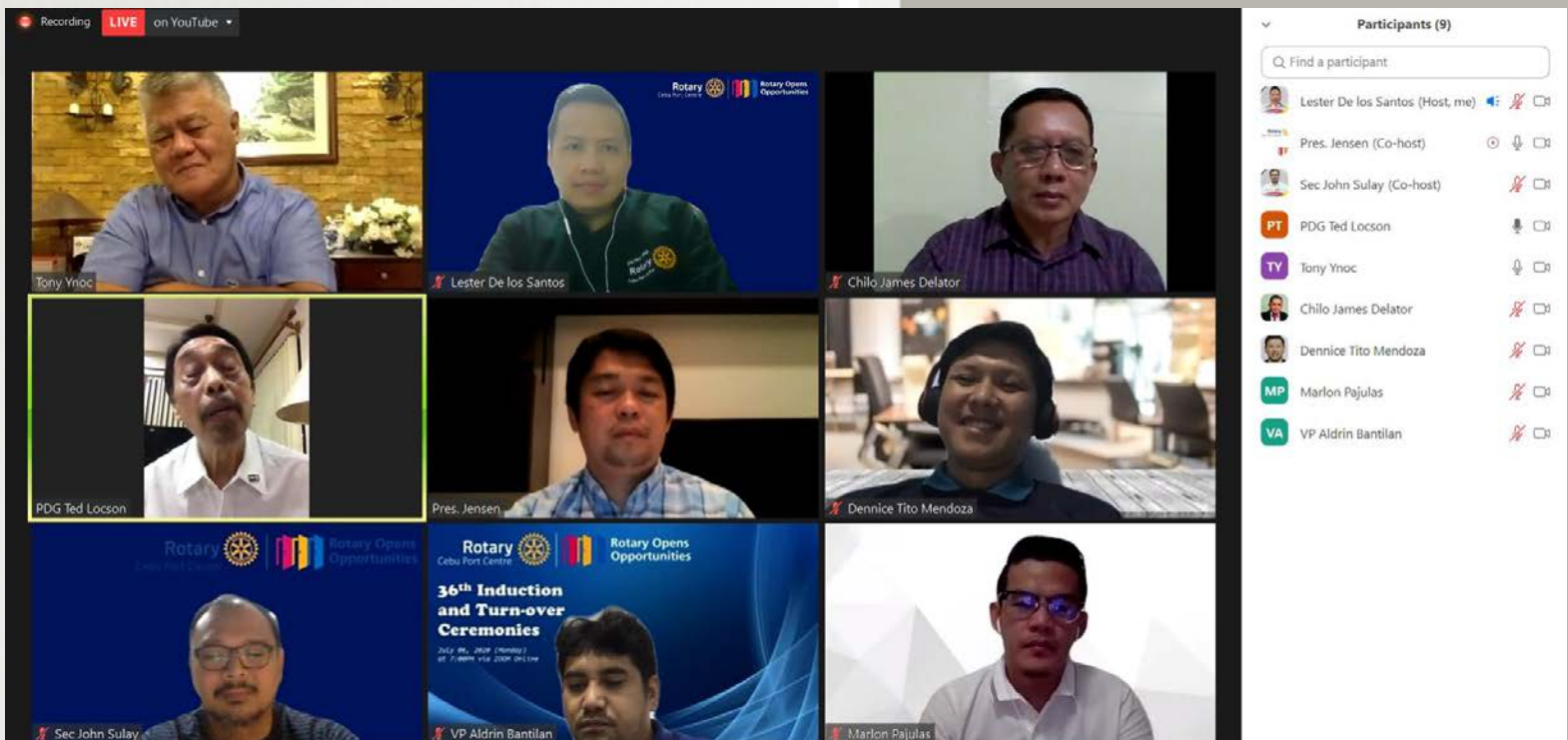

RCCPC Brief History

In the beginning were five men and one vision...

In a historic series of preparative meetings in May 1985, Felipe Casing, Antonio Elumir, Manny Granada, Jacinto Jamero and Rey Sanggalang envisioned the Port Center of Cebu as a vantage ground from where a band of noble men shall rise by the name of Rotary, in a game of service to humanity.

What followed was a marathon dash in establishing a Rotary Club in the Cebu Port District to obtain a charter from then District 3860 Governor Jose "Joe" Lardizabal whose term was to conclude very soon. On the forefront was Pepe Casing, a Cebu Fuente Rotarian.

It was in the special day of June 6, 1985 when a charter was granted to a club that was christened a most befitting name: The "ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER".

The newfound organization that was once a nucleus of five visionaries became a club of 34 gentlemen who convened charter members in the middle of June 1985 to bear witness to the first set of officers. Antonio "Jun" Elumir, who was then the Phil. Ports Authority Officer, was the Charter President. With him at the helm was Manuel "Manny" Granada, the charter vice-president, Jacinto "Boy" Jamero and "Rey" Sanggalang were the charter secretary and charter treasurer, respectively. These gentlemen who were the prime movers for the organization of our club were equally accorded those distinct and rare positions which can only happen once in a history of a club.

Pepe Casing was honored with the venerable title of "Godfather".

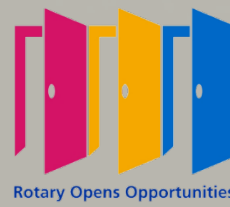

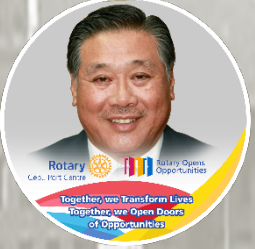

HIGHLIGHTS AND RECENT UPDATES ON COVID-19

As of 16 July 2020

- DOH recorded **38,183 active cases** with the majority of the patients exhibiting **mild symptoms** (34,619; 90.7%) while 173 **patients** are in **critical condition** (0.5%).
- DOH recorded **3,805 health care workers** positive for COVID 19 of which **3,093** has recovered (81%), 490 (13%) are mild cases, 186 are asymptomatic (5%), 1 severe and 35 (1%) has died.
- A total of **149,015** Returning Overseas Filipino arrived (Land-based: 68,768; Sea-based: 79,849 and 398 transferees from Sabah currently on quarantine). Of these, **142,085** were released from facility quarantine (Land-based: 64,284; Sea-based: 77,801).
- Among the Returning Overseas Filipino, **3,483** were confirmed COVID-19 (Land based: 1,826; Sea-based: 1,657). Among the confirmed COVID-19 ROF, 710 are currently admitted, 2,669 already recovered; and 1 has died. A total of **44** remains of deceased overseas Filipinos arrived, of which **19** were due to COVID-19.
- There are **5,216** HRH hired out of the 8,753 approved slots for emergency hiring in 307 health facilities. Of these, **42.6%** are hired in DOH hospitals, **16.5%** in COVID-19 diagnostic facility (including reference laboratories), **14.7%** in Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facility, **10.3%** in LGU and other hospitals, **6.5%** in COVID-19 referral facility, **3.5%** in Bureau of Quarantine managed quarantine facilities and airport units, **3.5%** in private health facilities (Region VII), **0.9%** in Mega Ligas COVID-19 Centers, **0.8%** in Epidemiology and Surveillance Units, **0.6%** for other healthcare facilities (Philippine Red Cross), and **0.2%** in Primary Care Facility.
- The DOH has deployed **334** post-residency physicians and redeployed **1,372** NDP nurses in DOH and LGU hospitals handling COVID-19 cases. In addition, there are **7,542** NDP nurses deployed in their respective communities who are involved in contact tracing and specimen collection (swabbing) and **3,893** public health associates who play active roles in contact tracing and surveillance. Other HRH who are in their assigned areas continue to provide essential health services in primary care and are also engaged in COVID-19 response, with focus on prevention of spread and surveillance in communities.

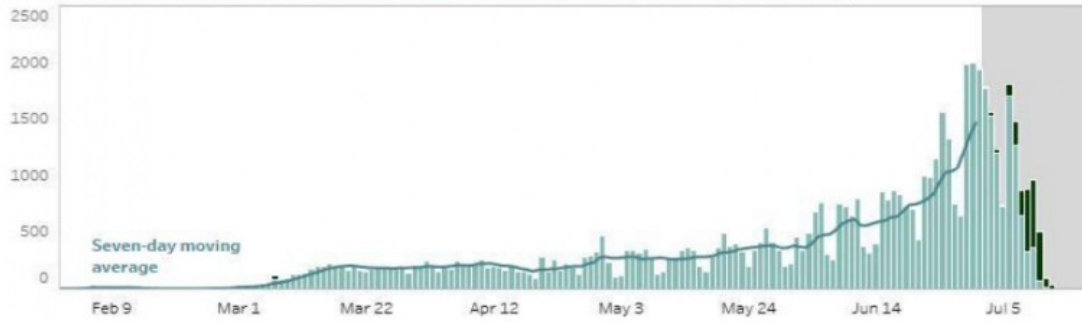

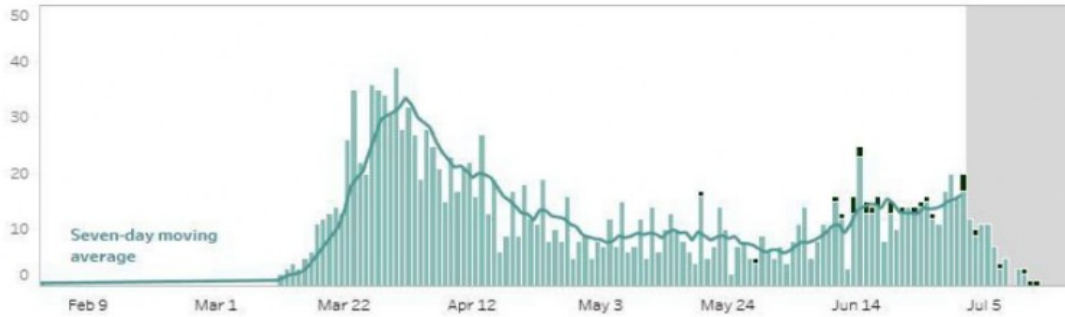

CONFIRMED CASES BY DATE OF ONSET OF ILLNESS (NATIONWIDE)

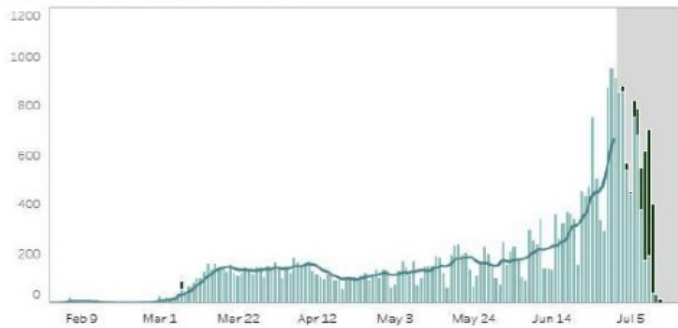


CONFIRMED DEATHS BY DATE OF DEATH (NATIONWIDE)

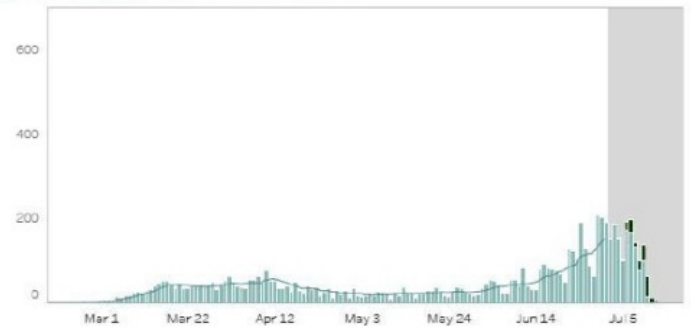

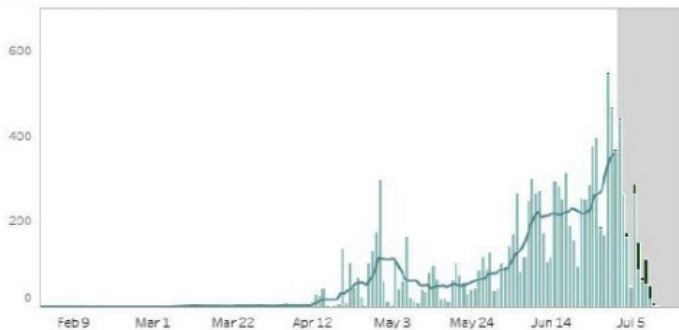
CONFIRMED CASES BY DATE OF ONSET OF ILLNESS (DISAGGREGATED)



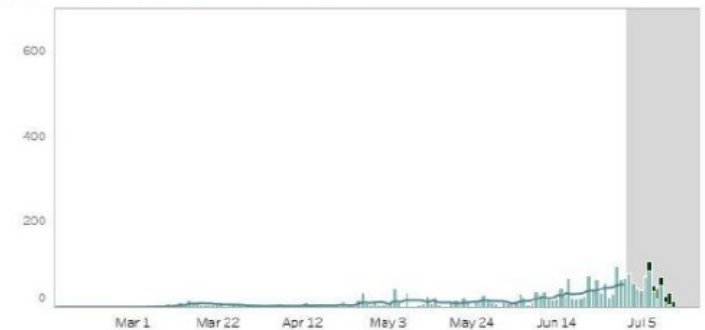
