For years, Susanne and I hosted many Rotary Youth Exchange students in our home. This program was an entry point to Rotary for me, and my heart is truly in it. When Rotary's exchange programs were suspended because of COVID-19 to keep students and families safe, we felt sorry, especially for the participants, because those years cannot be repeated.

2022. As we look ahead with hope, we thank Youth Exchange officers, host families, and volunteers for their contributions in years past, and we encourage districts to offer virtual exchanges as a way of connecting students around the world with each other and with our communities.

Because of the many uncertainties of the pandemic, the Rotary Board has decided to suspend in-person exchanges through June

For those who are not able to participate in Rotary Youth Exchange, Rotary offers other opportunities. New Generations Service Exchange (NGSE) is a Rotary program that deserves wider recognition: It is an excellent opportunity for young people ages 18 to 30 to participate in community service as individuals or in a group and to gain internship experience. Simukai Matshalaga, a Rotaractor from Zimbabwe, stayed with us in Ratzeburg during her NGSE experience three years ago.

*When I applied for the New Generations Service Exchange program, I did not realize that I was signing up for a life-changing experience. This program gave me that opportunity and much more. It taught me about the importance of failing fast, learning quicker, and being myself.*

*Some of my greatest experiences happened at the dinner table. The warmth and kindness of every home I lived in still resonate with me today. It took me weeks to understand how a stranger could care for me as deeply as these members of the Rotary family did. I am inspired by the lessons of humility I learned from all the amazing people I met. I came to understand a new culture and realized that the only things that separate us as people are our experiences and, at times, our false assumptions.*

# COVID UPDATE

## Covid-19 vaccine: your questions answered

Information from US CDC

Can the vaccine make me sick with Covid-19?

**NO**

→ None of the authorised/recommended vaccines in US (\*Pfizer/BioNTech and Moderna) contain the live virus that causes COVID-19

After vaccination, will I test positive for Covid-19 on a viral test?

**NO**

→ None of the authorised/recommended vaccines\* can cause positive viral tests, used to detect current infections

Will the vaccine alter my DNA?

**NO**

→ The Covid-19 messenger RNA vaccines do not change or interact with the DNA in any way

→ mRNA vaccines teach cells to make proteins that trigger an immune response, but never enter the cell nucleus, where the DNA is kept

Does the vaccine protect me from getting sick with Covid-19?

**YES\*\***

→ The vaccine teaches the immune system to recognise/fight the virus that causes Covid-19

→ \*\*Vaccines currently available have effectiveness range from 60 to 95%. Experts are still collecting data on the effects of the vaccines

If I recovered from Covid-19, do I still need a vaccine?

**YES**

→ There are severe health risks associated with Covid-19, and reinfection is possible



### VACCINATION

→ After vaccination, the body takes a few weeks to build immunity

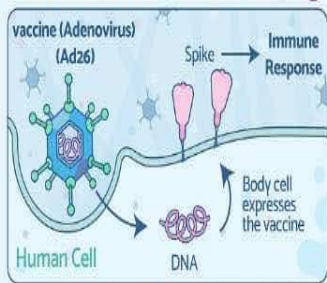

## **RCCPC Brief History**

*In the beginning were five men and one vision...*

*In a historic series of preparative meetings in May 1985, Felipe Casing, Antonio Elumir, Manny Granada, Jacinto Jamero and Rey Sanggalang envisioned the Port Center of Cebu as a vantage ground from where a band of noble men shall rise by the name of Rotary, in a game of service to humanity.*

*What followed was a marathon dash in establishing a Rotary Club in the Cebu Port District to obtain a charter from then District 3860 Governor Jose "Joe" Lardizabal whose term was to conclude very soon. On the forefront was Pepe Casing, a Cebu Fuente Rotarian. It was in the special day of June 6, 1985 when a charter was granted to a club that was christened a most befitting name: The "ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER".*

*The newfound organization that was once a nucleus of five visionaries became a club of 34 gentlemen who convened charter members in the middle of June 1985 to bear witness to the first set of officers. Antonio "Jun" Elumir, who was then the Phil. Ports Authority Officer, was the Charter President. With him at the helm was Manuel "Manny" Granada, the charter vice-president, Jacinto "Boy" Jamero and "Rey" Sanggalang were the charter secretary and charter treasurer, respectively. These gentlemen who were the prime movers for the organization of our club were equally accorded those distinct and rare positions which can only happen once in a history of a club.*

*Pepe Casing was honored with the venerable title of "Godfather".*
