

We are truly grateful to IECEP, ACPPI and our very own RCCPC and Sec. Aldrin.

- **2. February 18, 2022** Launching of the water drilling project for Barangay Taptap, Integrated School, Cebu to be led by Community Service Project Director Robert Barquilla and to be assisted by Barangay Capt. Brian Bontuyan for the project launching and turnover.
- **3.February 21-26, 2022** Another Serve to Change Lives Project will be implemented to the Typhoon Odette Victims in Barangay Calero, Liloan Coastal Barangay where Disaster Committee Chair PP Jun Falcon and in partnership with TAU Philippines were able to contribute and raise an amount of Php 130,000. It is also my advance gratitude to PAG Tony Ynoc and Rtn. Mark Ynoc who committed to help in the logistics and preparation of the area for the turn-over on the said date. The Turn-over ceremonies will be assisted by barangay Captain Luther Lauron where the said donations will be distributed to the identified 1,200 families whose homes were partially damaged and 186 families were totally homeless.

Through this noble project, we are then able to give hope to these families and we just hope that these kind of projects will come into meaningful fruition in the near future.

- **4. February 28, 2022** After all the hardwork and team work of our club, we all deserve a reward of fellowship. On the last Monday of the month (28th), we will have our 3rd Golf Fellowship at Alta Vista Golf to be led by PP Joel Valer and Enr. Jun Vinculado.

We are all inviting all of you Golf enthusiasts for our4th Golf Fellowship Game in Club Filipino and Summer Outing Fellowship at Cocopalms Resort, Danao, Cebu. R.I. President's Report (Feb 2022)



RI Pres Shekhar MehtaDiabetes in India, saw the urge President, Rotary International treat people who have diabetes.

At the start of the Rotary year, I challenged every club to plan and host at least one practical and action-oriented Rotary Day of Service. The event should address a challenge your community is facing that fits into one or more of Rotary's areas of focus and should bring together volunteers from within and outside of Rotary.

Rotary Days of Service can motivate Rotary, Rotaract, and Interact clubs to plan innovative and impactful projects. They can showcase your work as people of action and introduce prospective members to your club.

I've been inspired by your response so far, and I want to share with you just one project that has captured my imagination.

India is home to an estimated 74 million people with diabetes, a disease that is a leading cause of death. Furthermore, about 50 percent of those people remain undiagnosed.

Rotary, together with the Research Society for the Study of Diabetes in India, saw the urgent need to diagnose, track, and treat people who have diabetes.

Working together and with other organizations, we hosted a nationwide blood glucose testing camp on 29 September, which is World Heart Day.

The camp was spread across more than 10,000 sites in India, with more than 2,000 Rotary and Rotaract clubs participating in the effort. More than 1 million blood-sugar tests were conducted in a day, an accomplishment recognized by the Asia Book of Records. But more important than breaking a record is the fact that tens of thousands of people learned that they may be living with diabetes. They can now be treated for the condition, and they also have been made aware that they should take extra measures to shield themselves from COVID-19 and scores of other diseases that are caused or worsened by diabetes.

This month, on 23 February, the anniversary of Rotary, let us celebrate with more service days, showcasing Rotary's work in our areas of focus. I look forward to hearing about your Rotary Days of Service. Please share your projects on Rotary Showcase, or browse that webpage to find inspiration and project partners. In particular, I encourage you to execute projects that focus on empowering girls, as they have been disproportionately affected by the pandemic. The Empowering Girls initiative is resonating very well with members of Rotary as well as with non-Rotarians. The governments and NGOs in various countries are appreciating this meaningful effort. Let us keep focusing on it.

I am also happy that the Each One, Bring One ethos is bringing fruitful results. Let us ensure that all club members introduce at least one person to Rotary, and that we then all work to engage new members and keep them in our clubs.

In whatever we do, remember that we must push ourselves to grow more, do more as we Serve to Change Lives.







THE HISTORY OF ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER

In the beginning were five men and one vision...
In a historic series of preparative meetings in May 1985, Felipe
Casing, Antonio Elumir, Manny Granada, Jacinto Jamero and Rey
Sanggalang envisioned the Port Center of Cebu as a vantage
ground from where a band of noble men shall rise by the name of
Rotary, in a game of service to humanity.

What followed was a marathon dash in establishing a Rotary Club in the Cebu Port District to obtain a charter from then District 3860 Governor Jose "Joe" Lardizabal whose term was to conclude very soon. On the forefront was Pepe Casing, a Cebu Fuente Rotarian. It was in the special day of June 6, 1985 when a charter was granted to a club that was christened a most befitting name: The "ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU PORT CENTER".

The newfound organization that was once a nucleus of five visionaries became a club of 34 gentlemen who convened charter members in the middle of June 1985 to bear witness to the first set of officers. Antonio "Jun" Elumir, who was then the Phil. Ports Authority Officer, was the Charter President. With him at the helm was Manuel "Manny" Granada, the charter vice-president, Jacinto "Boy" Jamero and "Rey" Sanggalang were the charter secretary and charter treasurer, respectively. These gentlemen who were the prime movers for the organization of our club were equally accorded those distinct and rare positions which can only happen once in a history of a club.

Pepe Casing was honored with the venerable title of "Godfather".
