WHAT HAPPENED LAST WEEK...

BUSINESS MEETING

Like the previous week, our meeting was packed with a good mix of Rotarians and guests.

President Mike reported the success of our sign-up drive for the 6 Committees, thanks to the positive response of our members. Having attended his first Area Committee meeting of our District, he shared some of the activities being planned by the District this year. This information will be posted on our club calendar and presents a great way for us to meet other Rotarians from our area.

President Mike also announced that the tradition of hosting a children's party to celebrate the new Rotary year will happen this weekend. Our wards from Community Scouts, CSYGC, will be headed to Anjo World and Snow World in Minglanilla for a fun-filled day. Rotarians and their families were especially invited to take part in this event.

Our guest speaker, Ret. Lt. Gen. John Bonafos, turned out to be an unassuming man. Having once held one of the highest positions in the AFP, he was soft spoken and down to earth. This belied the kind of work he was engaged in, counter insurgency. He identified 2 major groups that threatened the security of our country, the armed wing of the Communist Party of the Philippines, AKA the NPA along with the different groups under its command. He identified the major areas where these armed groups operated and listed the various levels of activities, they engaged in. These ranged from direct attacks on the military, violent acts on civilians, collection of so-called revolutionary taxes, supply procurement, and even mere sightings. He pointed out that the latter was important because it reflects upon the attitude of the

civilians to report to the military whereas in the past, most were not willing to divulge this.

In his report, Cebu was not identified as a hotspot although there had been some sightings reported. On the other hand, some areas in the surrounding islands of Negros, Bohol, Panay and Samar were identified as hotbeds and the density of red dots that denoted a single incident of any kind made some areas in the map stand out. While they were far from Cebu to present any direct impact, it certainly made us more conscious of the fact that despite our city's development and robust economy, we can still be vulnerable.

The second part of the presentation covered an in-depth report of how the Abu Sayyaf incident in Bohol played out. He showed mugshots of the key players who were embarked on the mission, including the lone Prince on his test mission. Contrary to what the public had thought, the team was already being monitored as they left their lairs and the route of their travel had been traced. What was unknown until the last minute was the final destination which we all know to be in Panglao, Bohol. And the rest, as they say, is history. Our guest speaker presented a timeline of events, starting with their landing in Jagna, where one of the terrorist had family, down to where the military was able to track them down and eliminated the team, in twos, threes, even singly, until they finally eliminated the last of the terrorist. While the outcome of that suicide mission was a great reassurance to all Filipinos, it nevertheless presented a compelling argument as to why our government could not afford to be lax and complacent when it came to religious extremism.

Overall, his presentation was clear and certainly caught the attention of the audience. Were it not for the lack of time, the Q&A portion that should have followed would have been a lively one. We thanked our guest speaker for his most interesting talk and wish him all the best as he embarked on a new journey as a retired soldier.

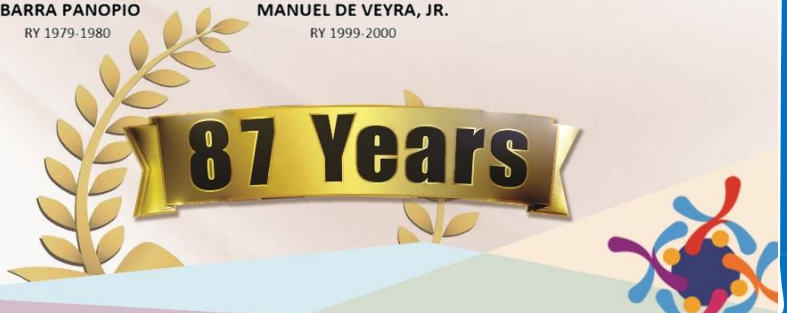

4. The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.


