Dispensing his servings of naught but corny jokes, he certainly elicited the laughter from the floor for his unique sense of humor. The groovy grandfather struck again!



One of the highlights of our weekly meeting has always been the fellowship signing by member of RCC. We usually invite our (un)lucky guests to join in and this day was no different. Unable to escape, Rtn. Shige Onda found himself in the company of our club Administrator Dir. Mitch and several of our guest hapless guests as they sang, or perhaps I should say, attempted to sing Bon Jovi's "You Give Love a Bad Name". With PP Joe Gapas clapping with much gusto to the tempo, they did a great job entertaining the rest of us. Good job boys!

Our guest speaker, Atty. Isaac Darcera, is the OIC and Asst. Chief, Legal Div. of the BIR in Cebu. He was no stranger to some Rotarians who happened to be his classmates in his younger days or had known him through family and mutual friends. It was interesting to note that prior to becoming a lawyer, Atty. Darcera had gone to school and graduated as an Occupational Therapist. Talk about a career change!

Speaking before a full packed audience of RCC members and guests, he started his talk with a short brief of what Revenue Regulations No. 4-2019 (RR 4-2019), otherwise known as the "Tax Amnesty Act." Was all about. Focusing first on the basics of the law such as definition of terms, coverage and exclusions, rates, procedures and factors that could affect an application, then delving deeper into issues that complicate a filing, immunities and privilege, delinquencies, etc. and the various angles one had to consider when availing of the Amnesty.

Then Atty. Darcera moved on to how this law can be applied to real properties, which is perhaps one of the most common but pressing challenges heirs of a decedent is very likely to face. Based on the rapt attention given to him by the audience, no doubt he had hit the nail on the head. Even as the minute hand moved past the hour, no one took leave as he began sharing what one can consider his FAQ. Clearly he's done this many time and knew what were the more likely questions to be asked so he came prepared. It was detailed and lengthy but informative.

He concluded his presentation and entertained a few questions which had to be shortened as it was already minutes past 2. For the reference of our members and guests, his presentation was shared to us and can be given

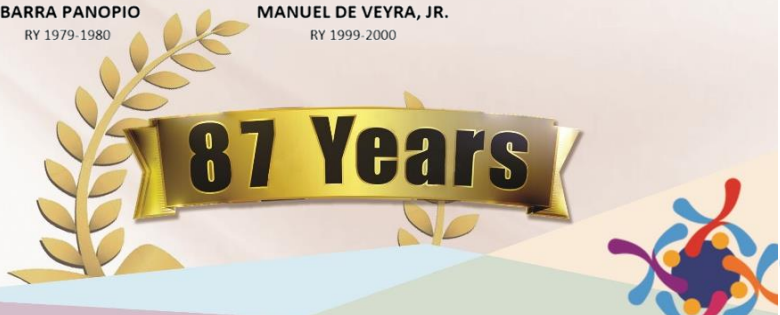

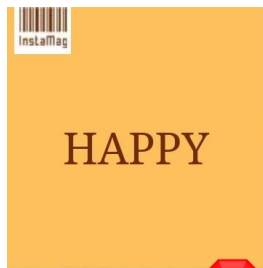

This global grant allowed the school to upgrade three tech-voc classes with new tools

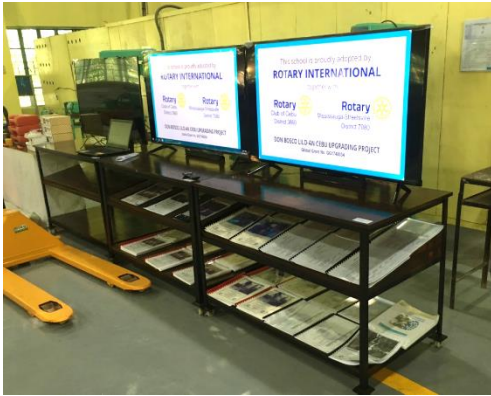


and equipment for carpentry, furniture technology, and shielded metal arc welding. The grant allowed the school to introduce a new tech-voc class in electrical
