No Rotary club in the world can possibly serve all segments of its community. Therefore, we must organize new clubs to engage the community leaders who cannot connect with our existing clubs.

Growing Rotary is all about taking the connections that make our organization unique in the world and strengthening and multiplying them. Let us commit ourselves to growing Rotary and to welcoming the next diverse generation of women and men as *Rotary Connects the World*.

BUSINESS MEETING

Our last meeting of the month went off to a good start, thanks in part to the presence of 4 birthday celebrants who gamely answered the call to lead in fellowship singing. Perhaps it was due to the wine and cheese, or the full stomach from a good meal so they sang Bee Gee's "To Love Somebody". Or dare I say they tried to sing like Bee Gees. One thing for sure was Bee Gees they were not! But the spirit was strong and they were rewarded with their own birthday cake at the end of their rendition.



Our guest speaker was Dan Hapolito. Dan is an ECE who had worked with different companies in the technology space. Currently he's connected with Dell Technologies as their Systems Engineer (Philippines) and happened to just be in town for our meeting. He shared with us his thoughts on IT Transformation of businesses. He identified the 4 areas that it covers namely, Digital, IT, Workforce, and Security.

While technology presents the opportunity to take the big leap for many companies, it also presents many challenges and therefore one cannot jump

right in without changing the mindset of your organization's leaders and staff.



He identified these areas that need to be transformed and where pitfalls may be present. An example in the Digital area will be the transformation of traditional hard copies and physical files into digital format. Moving information into a space that will allow wider access and provide faster results. IT transformation may involve investments in modernizing or creating a data center, automating manual tasks, and changing operation procedures. Yet doing this without training and the support of your workforce will create an insurmountable challenge. More so when your staff fear they are being replaced and are just resistant to change. And if this wasn't enough concern, you now have to consider the exposure of confidential data; so a new mindset in handling data security has to be in place.

Overall, it was an interesting presentation, albeit a bit of a deep dive for some in the audience. But this is what our talks are all about. It should touch on areas that we are not familiar with, and on some days, it may even be on topics we are not comfortable with. For at the end of our meeting, when a member leaves with the joy of fellowship and more information that he came in with, he had certainly attended a good meeting.


