BUSINESS MEETING

With President Mike away, PE Edward Gaisano took the helm of our luncheon



meeting and called it to order. Since TRF Chair Doc Baba was our speaker, the lineup at the presidential table were all RCC members. And when you add Rtn. Shige into the mix as the emcee, our gathering was punctuated with much laughter and jokes.

PE Ed informed everyone that Pres. Mike was visiting Russia together with PP Jonie to witness the sisterhood agreement between Russia's sole Rotary District and ours. He then shared the President's message with emphasis on the District's upcoming efforts on polio eradication, and segued into PP Bernard conducting a more in-depth discussion of the Walk to End Polio this Sunday, followed by the details of next

month's Ride to End Polio Cebu. This is a daunting challenge and kudos go to PP Bernard for spearheading this under his term as the District's End Polio Chair.

He introduced the members of RCC who are undertaking this 550KM ride. The aim of this ride is to increase awareness of Cebuanos to the reemerging scourge of polio



and how a simple and safe vaccination can eliminate that risk. Secondly, it is to raise up to ₱2.0M in pledges from our network of clubs,

family and friend. Pledge forms were distributed to those of us who were there. While not all of us have the capacity and stamina to even consider joining that ride, ALL of us can help with raising money through pledges so let's all wade in and aim for the target. The ride happens in less than 2 months so we do need to get moving!

If there was anyone who knows everything about The Rotary Foundation like you know your parents, it would be our beloved Doc Baba. And by golly he did not fail us as he distilled the journey of how funds that we give to TRF makes its way from the donor to RI and how and where



it goes before making its way back to the club, provided the club knows how to make good use of it. He shared data on where RI stands when compared to other organizations when it comes to the utilization of funds; suffice to say RI has one of the lowest cost of managing these funds. More bang for the buck.

Doc Baba also shared the concept of The Paul Harris Society which recognizes Rotary members and friends of The Rotary Foundation who elect to contribute \$1,000 or more each year to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus Fund, or approved global grants. In RCC our club matches members' donations so that \$500 instead of \$1000 already gets you recognized as a Paul Harris Fellow. This should be an incentive for us to give and give freely. He also explained the different types Donor Recognition from Benefactor, PHF, PHS (\$1000/yr.), and Major Donors Level 1 (\$10,000) up to level 4 (\$100k-\$249k), and of course the AKS that starts at \$250k and upwards.

He shared a brief summary of how RCC has benefited from District and Global Grants that can be traced back to what we gave to TRF. Projects that has made significant impact in the lives of many Cebuanos. And he also mapped our club members' to the realm of donor recognition from TRF. It clearly shows we have donated generously and RCC is UP there when it comes to TRF donations among all Rotary clubs in our country! Nevertheless, we only play a small part in the grand scheme of Rotary International so one can never rest on our laurels when it comes to giving. All in all,

it was a great meeting and there is much for us to learn when it came to TRF and with Doc Baba breathing down our necks, we are in good hands.

ABOUT RIDE TO END POLIO

This coming November 22-24, 2019, Rotary Club of Cebu will hold the first ever Ride to End Polio Cebu. This is a 550-kilometer ride composing of Rotarians and friends of Rotary cyclists with the main goal of raising funds to provide vaccines for the island of Cebu. This 3-day ride also aims to create awareness that polio is a deadly yet very preventable disease. We are hopeful that we can raise vaccination rate to 95%.

ABOUT ROTARY & POLIO

Rotary's global quest is eradication of polio in the world; the goal is to make every child safe from the ravages of this terrible disease. Since 1985, Rotary has helped reduce the incidence of polio more than 99+% (from 1000 cases per day to less than 230 per year); more than two billion children around the world has received oral polio vaccine. In 1979, Rotary International's first efforts at eradicating polio was here in the Philippines. The last case of Polio was reported in 1993 and by year 2000, we were declared polio-free. Just recently, Polio cases were discovered. We are "this close", but we need to finish the job, and you can help by raising funds with your pledge in the Ride to End Polio.



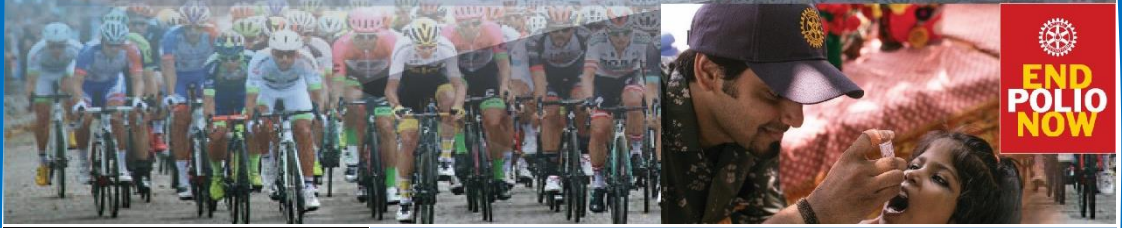
