Since Rotary's Major Donor recognition began there are over 18,000 Major Donor.

For those donors whose cumulative gifts total US\$25,000 or more are considered an Arch C. Klumph Society and are inducted AT THE World Headquarters in Evanston and permanently displayed. (There are 453 Arch C. Klumph Society members as of June 2013)



## **End Polio Now Campaign - Toledo**

Polio Kills. Get Vaccinated. End Polio NOW.

Poblacion, Toledo — While the Ride to End Polio Campaign is on their 3rd day on the northern parts of Cebu, another group of Rotarians along with their Rotaractors went to Toledo to provide mass polio vaccination in a health center. President Mike Torres of RC Cebu headed the activity along with other Rotarians from RC Cebu and RC Metro Cebu. The group was warmly welcomed by an estimate of 150 beneficiaries that were patiently waiting and excited to have their children vaccinated.



Aside from the free polio vaccination, the Rotarians also initiated to give loot bags after the vaccination to the beneficiaries. Rotaract club of Cebu members handled the re-packing and organizing of goods to the loot bags, which were then distributed

to the beneficiaries. It was a fulfilling activity as we see the children getting their shots of polio vaccine with the added goods that were distributed to the families. As we make our way back to city proper, it is our hope that other areas which have not yet been reached and awareness is still low will be reached out and identified as well as we aim to fully eradicate polio disease. So that from 'we are this close' in ending polio, we could finally say that we have ended and eradicated polio.

After the mass polio vaccination in Toledo, we went to Plaza Independencia to await, meet and welcome the riders of the Ride to End Polio campaign and our fellow club members who went along with them for three consecutive days. The culminating activity was the final leg of their ride and we can see how proud and fulfilling it was for the riders and the people who went along with them as they finally reach the culminating area. It was a 3-days full activity of mass polio vaccination in different areas of Cebu, but surely our fight to end polio doesn't stop yet from there. We will continue to spread awareness and give vaccines until we fully eradicate polio.

- ② High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;
- The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;
- ① The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.
