Fellow Rotarians today is a great day as we will be having two important events.



I like to quote Confucius at many Rotary events, because his ideas are so much like ours. Confucius would have been a great Rotarian. Take this Confucius quote, for example: "The failure to cultivate virtue, the failure to examine and analyze what I have learned, the inability to move toward righteousness after being shown the way, the inability to correct my faults — these are the causes of my grief."

If you turn the saying around to positive language, it sounds exactly like the first goal of the new Rotary Action Plan. When we talk about Rotary increasing our impact, mean investing we relationships, making decisions grounded in evidence, mobilizing our resources to create solutions that last. learning and always from our experiences.

The Rotary Foundation already does this so well and will continue to be the best possible investment in a better world as the Action Plan is put into effect. Our global grants respond to real community needs. That's because we approve them only after a rigorous community assessment. Then the projects are tailored to the information uncovered during the assessment.

Now your Foundation is making a difference on a broader scale than ever through our programs of scale grants. These are competitive grants, designed to respond to a need that a community has identified. Programs of scale will benefit a large number of people in a significant geographic area. They will be sustainable, evidence-based interventions with measurable outcomes and impact. Each grant will support, for three to five years, activities that align with one or more of Rotary's areas of focus.

Programs of scale build on our experience in the eradication of polio, and we must never forget that we still have important work to do to eliminate this disease. When I visited Pakistan in November, I was overjoyed to see so many young Rotary leaders working hard for End Polio Now.

Wonderful things are happening with our global grants, and the Rotary Action Plan will help us do more than ever. Let us continue to cultivate virtue, examine and analyze what we learn, move toward righteousness based on our new knowledge, and keep improving everything we do.

#### WHAT HAPPENED LAST WEEK...

Going Up with Mobile Apps

Last week, our guest speaker came to us with an interesting topic for his talk," Going Up with Mobile Apps". Wylie Chavez is CEO & Founder of APP Up, an app development company. He started off by sharing cartoon drawings that depicted how mobile gadgets have taken over our lives. Scenes like a family who shared a meal, but each cocooned in their own world, glued to their respective devices. Of how couples used to cuddle in bed, to talk about their day now immersed in their gadgets. He spoke of times when kids had to be coerced to come home and now, they have to be coerced to go out. How times have changed with our

handheld devices. In fact, there is a term coined to describe an irrational fear of being without your gadgets, called "Nomophobia".



After Wyllie shared these interesting facts with us, he began to take baby steps to explain what apps are, what YouTube is, and even basic information like what social media apps are, Facebook, and how you get them on your phone. I felt like he was an American trying to teach English to natives. I must declare that while we do have many baby boomers in our midst, we as a club are fairly up to date with the use of smartphones and modern apps for communication within our club, friends and family. Often, I felt like telling him dude, we know those things. But we must give him the leeway, after all he didn't really know us.



He shared an example of why advertising on YouTube gives your ad a higher chance of being seen by others. Why an app that shows advertising gives a better rate of return that advertising on traditional media. He cited impressive figures when we look at the number of users of popular apps like Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc. Imagine your message being carried by these apps. Therein lies his strongest reason for developing apps - because developers can earn millions through ads that are shown to users of their mobile app. Personally. I thought that line of thinking is a tad too optimistic as it still requires people to download your app, use it and keep it on their phones.

Business to Consumer (B2C) mobile apps are designed to reach out to the market and Cebu Pacific app is one example. It was created for convenience as it allows passengers buy tickets from the comfort of their homes or phones. Saving them from having to line up in a ticket office. Business to Business (B2B) mobile apps are internal apps such as a sales app which monitors the sales performance of your team and handles the assignment of team targets by the boss.

Wylie recommended that we look into Third Party App (TPA) and see how we can integrate the app into our registration process for Run for Gift of Life. He showed how one can use a t-shirt ordering app called Wurd to order а t-shirt with vour own design. And Wylie suggested we tap



the power of this app to handle our t-shirt design needs.

Wylie ended his talk by sharing some of the apps he had developed. With names like Queue app, Freelance app, SOS app and the Laundry app. Having been involved in app development in my past endeavors, I wish him all the best as it is no easy feat. I mean, how do you stand out from the hundreds of thousands of apps that are currently posted on Google Play or the App Store? How do you make your app relevant enough for people to install them and keep it when the phone is already preloaded with basic apps to the wazoo? One can always hope for the best and for Wylie, he's banking on the next Facebook of the future.






# "ROTI Day 3.0 - A Fight against Hunger"





God has blessed us immeasurable ways so that we can, in return, bless and help others.
