Chartered on November 28, 1932, Rotary Club of Cebu is the second oldest club in the Philippines. The club currently has 63 members and prides itself in the quality of its members and the excellent fellowship that characterizes its weekly meetings.

The club sponsored the organization of several Rotary clubs in the Visayas and has produced six district governors, including Vicente L. Faelnar,

Joaquin Panis, Vicente Lozada, Federico Reyes and Manuel de Veyra. The latest, Edgar Chiongbian, was the District Governor in RY2013-2014 and also the RY2017-2018 Chairman of the Philippine College of Rotary Governors.

Rotary International District 3860 has consistently recognized the club for its role and contribution to the District, winning the Club of the Year and President of the Year awards multiple times over the years. Our members continue to donate generously to The Rotary Foundation and consistently leads

the District in TRF Donations and Disaster relief drives. The club has long led the district with the greatest number of Major Donors (15 currently) and in RY2019-2020, three members of the club (one posthumously) inducted into the Arch Klumph Society, the first AKS members in our District. Likewise, RCC was the first club to establish a TRF Endowment Fund in the District. Lastly, the RCC has been very active in Global Grant projects, leading the country with almost 5% of the total approved Philippine global grant budget over the past six years.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

July 22, 2022

Last week started with attending the Monday night induction & installation of President Buboy Tan of the Rotary Club of Cebu Port Center. RCCPC is one of the larger clubs in Cebu and they are very active. They are also known for fielding very talented golfers in our district's fellowship. Governor Lilu & other dignitaries from the district were also in attendance. Our club was duly represented by yours truly together with DFRC Stephen Chian, PAG and current District Membership Chair Mike Torres, AG Bing Martinez and our incredible imaginative Secretary Edward "Doc" Tan Ting. It did not take long for this group of thirsty gentlemen to polish the fine Suntory scotch offered by our host, Past Pres. Koike and surely made the evening quite enjoyable. I had a great time and I wish Pres. Buboy the best of luck as he leads his club this year.

By Thursday PE Walter and I flew to Manila to renew our club's Brotherhood Agreement with RC Makati. The event was held in their impressive multi-storey club building and more than a handful of other clubs from Luzon were there for the same reason. The highlight that evening was the iberico lechon cutting ceremony of Rotarian Freddy Borromeo (an International Service Awardee).

It was interesting to note that in all the years I have enjoyed lechon, not once have I seen so much attention paid towards the first act of slicing and chopping of the roasted pig. Many dignitaries took turns to stand over the lechon, knife in hand and in the act of cutting it open from end to end. Needless to say the practice drew many people and made the evening more festive. I can just imagine Cang's lechon will be starting the lechon cutting ceremony in Cebu soon thanks to Walter!

After a simple but meaningful program, Presidents from their brother clubs were ushered one floor below for the renewal of our brotherhood agreements. We were lead to an impressive board room and in the middle sat their VP Howie Calleja and Dir Sonny Tambunting Jr.. (President Michael Escaler had to leave for another engagement). Then Presidents from each club were invited to sit beside them to jointly sign their respective agreements, exchange of banners and tokens changed hands. All these happen while pictures are being taken. When all was done, we

all shook hands and we were sent off our copy of the signed agreement, club banner, coffee table book and their token in a bag as you head back to the party. As you leave, another club takes their turn and the whole thing is repeated. It was very efficient, smooth and well managed, reminding me of a production line. I have to hand it to them as they had it down to a science.

As the evening wore on, they had an open mike session and by golly could they sing! While many of their members were likely captains of their industry, I joked that a very polished talent for carrying a tune must be one of their prerequisites to join the club!

Over the evening, we made sure to do our rounds and chatted with their members. People like PP David Ackerman who is perhaps the youngest AKS member I have met. PDG Sid Garcia, PDG Bimbo Mills, PP Peter Manzano, IPP Louie Aseoche. They all received us warmly and expressed great interest to work with us this Rotary year. Indeed, it is an irony that we have not done any joint projects with them. Having joined one of their golf fellowships years ago, I invited them to Cebu for our 90th Anniversary celebration and play golf with our members. This idea was well received and I hope to see this happen in November. Perhaps at that time we can also kick off our joint project?

RC Makati is in a unique position that their coffers are so packed they fund their own projects. Global Grants? Nope. They provide funding without the need for it due to the benefit of recurring revenues from their club assets to the tune of more than forty million pesos each year. Their club even covers travel expenses of members who visit other clubs representing RCM and subsidize their weekly luncheon meetings. Like us, they are also a mother club in their District so many of their daughter clubs work closely with them to fund projects in their neck of the woods. They are surely a powerhouse brother club I think our club can benefit greatly from a deeper engagement, beyond a piece of paper. I wish to change this as it just makes sense.

We were one of the last to leave that evening and I'd say we were able to make our presence count and verbalized our serious intent to strengthen our ties. There's more to be said about their induction the following day but I shall leave it to PE Walter to share in his article here. Something tells me we have a lot of work to do to prepare for our big 90th anniversary celebration.






