

The club has long led the district with the greatest number of Major Donors (15 currently) and in RY2019-2020, three members of the club posthumously) inducted into the Arch Klumph Society, the first AKS members in our District. Likewise, RCC was the first club to establish a TRF Endowment Fund in the District. Lastly, the RCC has been very active in Global Grant projects, leading the country with almost 5% of the total approved Philippine global grant budget over the past six years.

were evaluated. Hearing of our plans, a few of our generous members have already pledged amounts that give us confidence that our plan is rock solid and air tight.




