

### **ROTARY CLUB OF CEBU**

Chartered on November 28, 1932, Rotary Club of Cebu is the second oldest club in the Philippines. The club currently has 63 members and prides itself in the quality of its members and the excellent fellowship that characterizes its weekly meetings.

The club sponsored the organization of several Rotary clubs in the Visayas and has produced six district governors, including Vicente L. Faelnar,

Joaquin Panis, Vicente Lozada, Federico Reyes and Manuel de Veyra. The latest, Edgar Chiongbian, was the District Governor in RY2013-2014 and also the RY2017-2018 Chairman of the Philippine College of Rotary Governors.

Rotary International District 3860 has consistently recognized the club for its role and contribution to the District, winning the Club of the Year and President of the Year awards multiple times over the years. Our members continue to donate generously to The Rotary Foundation and consistently leads

the District in TRF Donations and Disaster relief drives. The club has long led the district with the greatest number of Major Donors (15 currently) and in RY2019-2020, three members of the club (one posthumously) inducted into the Arch Klumph Society, the first AKS members in our District. Likewise, RCC was the first club to establish a TRF Endowment Fund in the District. Lastly, the RCC has been very active in Global Grant projects, leading the country with almost 5% of the total approved Philippine global grant budget over the past six years.


## WHAT HAPPENED LAST MEETING.....

Our guest speaker last week was Dr. Peter Mancao. I first heard of him when I chaired our club's Gift of Life program a few years back. At that time, we, I looked after the Vocational Training Team program at VSMMC. As most of you will remember, we had some challenges in mounting the program but it gave a wonderful opportunity for our club and its members to rise to the occasion. I happened to meet Dr. Mancao in a social gathering and mentioned what we were doing. It turns out that he was privy to our program and shared his thoughts on how to address some of the challenges we were facing.

Years later I was surprised to hear and see that he has stepped into the world of politics. Perhaps it was a calling or a passion that only found the right path recently, but there he was on the campaign trail. Like most political neophytes, he didn't make the cut. But then I don't think most neophytes make it on their first try. He was just stepping into the arena and perhaps his "real" time will come in a few years.

Nevertheless his effort did catch the attention of his friend, Mayor Mike Rama who appointed him as his Special Assistant for the much maligned, much controversial, much discussed, Cebu City Medical Center. If anything can be said, Dr. Mancao didn't sugarcoat his presentation. CCMC's journey of agony began when the last strong earthquake that hit Cebu made it structurally unsafe so it had to be torn down. And so as they began to build the new home, problems began to emerge. In a nutshell they faced numerous delays, change of contractors, even damage from a fire from an adjoining lot, exhausted funds, and of course, politics. As they say, the hits just kept on coming.





But there is hope. Dr. Mancao shared that to date, several floors have already become operational. Imaging equipment acquired years back are now online, Even an ICU facility is now open. He shared his hope that one day, CCMC will become the city's go-to for excellent public medical care. But indeed they still have a ways to go. Among some of the challenges they face is the ever dwindling funds of the city to continue financing the construction of the



upper floors. Even our city's Mayor has appealed for funding from both public and private offices. Nothing is being held back, including the naming rights for certain floors and sections of the hospital.

How the saga for CCMC will end remains to be seen. But I certainly hope it will not take another round of election! Other cities have managed to plan, construct, and operate their hospital in just a few years so there is no reason why the city with all its pride and resources can falter. I wish Dr. Mancao all the best in his undertaking and that perhaps he may one day look back at his career and consider this as a jewel of his experiences. I long for the time when we can really say CCMC will be truly functional and ready to meet the needs of the Cebuano community.



CALBASAAN INTEGRATED SCHOOL. Situated high up in the mountains of Minglanilla. It doesn't have a steady supply of water. Students walk to from a spring hundreds of meters away under the scorching heat of the sun or torrents of rain. Badly damaged by a supertyphoon. Imagine being in a cramped classroom, with toilets but no water. That's the situation of over 300 children enrolled this school year.



Starting next week, the club through the Rotary International District 3860 Philippines fund will repair the roof and will kickoff the WASH project aimed at providing a sustainable water system through a global grant in partnership with Rotary International Clubs of Kasugai and Sydney Cove.
