Chartered on November 28, 1932, Rotary Club of Cebu is the second oldest club in the Philippines. The club currently has 63 members and prides itself in the quality of its members and the excellent fellowship that characterizes its weekly meetings.

The club sponsored the organization of several Rotary clubs in the Visayas and has produced six district governors, including Vicente L. Faelnar,

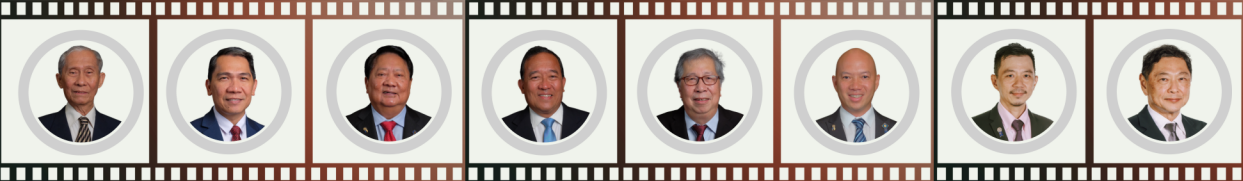
Joaquin Panis, Vicente Lozada, Federico Reyes and Manuel de Veyra. The latest, Edgar Chiongbian, was the District Governor in RY2013-2014 and also the RY2017-2018 Chairman of the Philippine College of Rotary Governors.

Rotary International District 3860 has consistently recognized the club for its role and contribution to the District, winning the Club of the Year and President of the Year awards multiple times over the years. Our members continue to donate generously to The Rotary Foundation and consistently leads

the District in TRF Donations and Disaster relief drives. The club has long led the district with the greatest number of Major Donors (15 currently) and in RY2019-2020, three members of the club (one posthumously) were inducted into the Arch Klumph Society, the first AKS members in our District. Likewise, RCC was the first club to establish a TRF Endowment Fund in the District. Lastly, the RCC has been very active in Global Grant projects, leading the country with almost 5% of the total approved Philippine global grant budget over the past six years.

## WHAT HAPPENED LAST MEETING.....

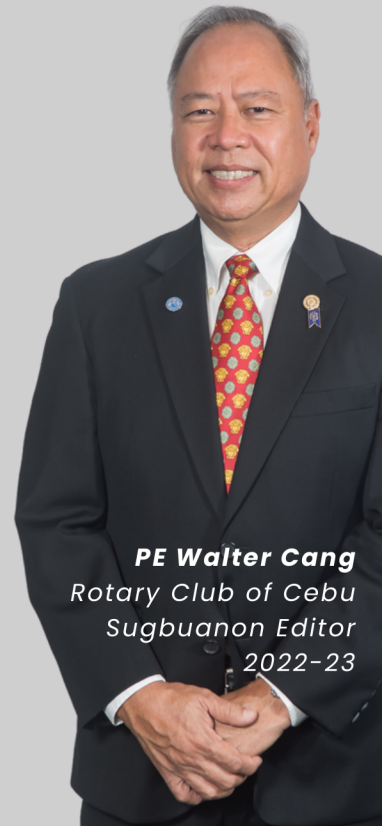
As an audience in a show, one is not privy to all the things that happen behind the stage. You notice what appears on stage but never deeply appreciate how it was achieved and how much work had to happen. Unless you were offered a glimpse of what goes on behind the curtain.

That's exactly what our guest speaker, Mr. Raul Lucero did last week. As President and COO of VECO, we heard it straight from the horse's mouth, so they say. Raul took us on a virtual journey of how they had tracked the storm days before it hit our shores. They knew it was a strong one and they even knew the exact time it was going to cross our island. But like everyone else, they didn't know how it was going to impact the island.

Raul explained the steps they took to address what they expected would be substantial damage from the typhoon. They had already tapped their peers in the industry to send their team and heavy equipment to Cebu. They lined up their inventory of supplies, equipment, fuel, and spare parts. They even repurposed their lobby into a command center and another building into living quarters for the expected team that will fan out to repair the lines each day.

More interesting anecdotes he shared include having to provide unlimited beer for consumption each evening to prevent staff from going out to drink and catch Covid. How they prioritized low-income areas, hospitals and water pumping stations and left wealthy gated communities for last since homeowners there could afford emergency power. How repair teams from other islands couldn't travel as our ports were closed due to damage. Of how politicians from many levels hoped to influence where repairs were going to be undertaken. And like many of us, they barely had time to look after their own homes and families before they began to help their customers.

He explained how their tall 70KVA towers were brought down by the combined weight of their shorter poles that toppled when trees fell on them or into their supporting cables. In appreciation for the assistance from repair teams of other companies, they provided laundry service, air-conditioned

rooms, food and free parts and labor for all their heavy equipment.

There were lessons learned no doubt. They leveraged information gained from experience and best practices. But as they say, the best laid plans of mice and men often go awry. So new lessons were added to their guidebook that may once again see the light in the future, and may I hope, far far future!.

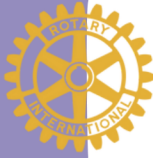

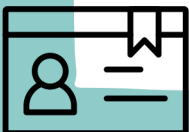

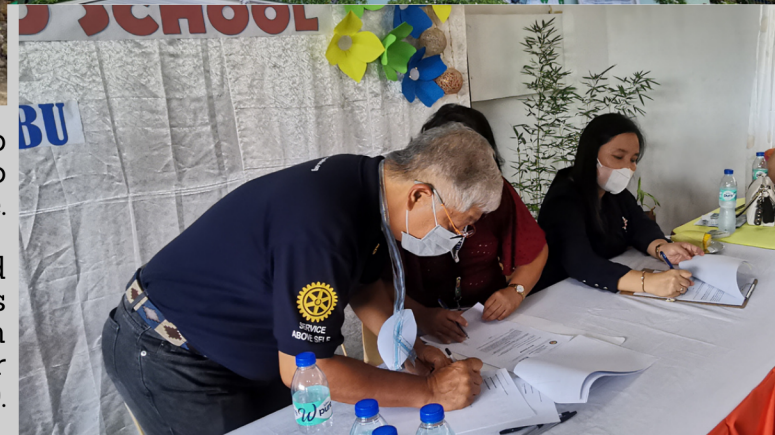
