Chartered on November 28, 1932, Rotary Club of Cebu is the second oldest club in the Philippines. The club currently has 63 members and prides itself in the quality of its members and the excellent fellowship that characterizes its weekly meetings.

The club sponsored the organization of several Rotary clubs in the Visayas and has produced six district governors, including Vicente L. Faelnar,

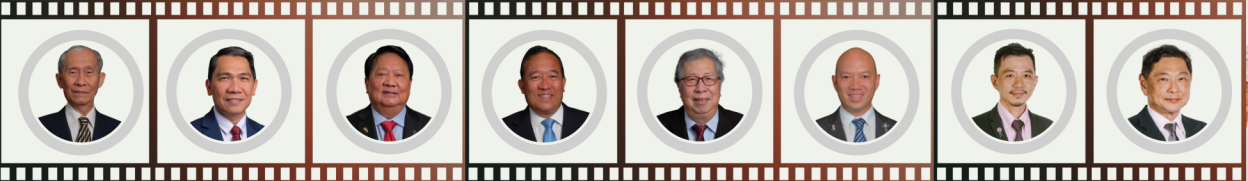
Joaquin Panis, Vicente Lozada, Federico Reyes and Manuel de Veyra. The latest, Edgar Chiongbian, was the District Governor in RY2013-2014 and also the RY2017-2018 Chairman of the Philippine College of Rotary Governors.

Rotary International District 3860 has consistently recognized the club for its role and contribution to the District, winning the Club of the Year and President of the Year awards multiple times over the years. Our members continue to donate generously to The Rotary Foundation and consistently leads

the District in TRF Donations and Disaster relief drives. The club has long led the district with the greatest number of Major Donors (15 currently) and in RY2019-2020, three members of the club (one posthumously) were inducted into the Arch Klumph Society, the first AKS members in our District. Likewise, RCC was the first club to establish a TRF Endowment Fund in the District. Lastly, the RCC has been very active in Global Grant projects, leading the country with almost 5% of the total approved Philippine global grant budget over the past six years.

TRUSTEE CHAIR'S MESSAGE

Who are your Rotary heroes? One of mine was Clem Renouf, 1978-79 RI president. I related to Sir Clem, who died in 2020, in many ways. We shared the same profession and Australian nationality and a passion for polio eradication. It was Clem's leadership that first put us on track to embrace the cause, mobilizing what is today a global partnership that has led us to the cusp of eradicating a human disease for only the second time in history.

What Rotary and its partners have achieved is nothing short of remarkable. We have helped reduce polio cases by 99.9 percent worldwide, immunizing more than 2 billion children across 122 countries. Last year alone, more than 370 million children were vaccinated across 30 countries, using more than 1 billion doses of oral polio vaccine. As a result, we are seeing near historic lows in the number of cases. In August 2020, the World Health Organization African region was certified free of wild poliovirus, an incredible achievement for Rotary members and a huge step on the road to eradication.

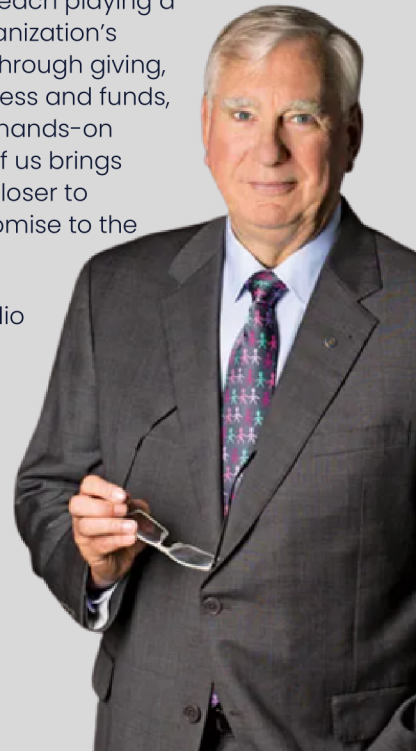
But remember that as long as polio exists anywhere, it is a threat to people everywhere, especially to young children. You may have heard about importations of the disease to Malawi and Mozambique, detection of poliovirus in sewage in the UK, and a recent case in the U.S.

To stay agile, Rotary and its partners are deploying a new polio vaccine, novel oral polio

vaccine type 2 (nOPV2), to fight outbreaks of circulating vaccine-derived poliovirus, also known as variant poliovirus, which continues to threaten children in Africa, as well as several countries in Asia and the Middle East, including Afghanistan and Pakistan.

Rotary is as active as ever. We are calling on every member to take action and be part of this historic fight. Take the fight to your clubs and communities on World Polio Day, 24 October. Keep raising awareness of the importance of polio eradication and Rotary's critical role in that effort by holding events and fundraisers. Don't forget that contributions toward the goal of \$50 million per year for polio eradication will be matched 2-to-1 by our generous partner, the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.

Like Sir Clem, we can all be Rotary heroes, each playing a part in our organization's great legacy. Through giving, raising awareness and funds, and providing hands-on service, each of us brings Rotary a step closer to fulfilling our promise to the children of the world by eradicating polio for good.



PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

October 13, 2022

As a Rotarian, I know how important it is to give to The Rotary Foundation. The more we give, the more we eventually get back. But as you know, I am now advocating that we also set aside a bit of our funds to the Cebu Rotary Club Foundation for a rainy day. Putting funds into our foundation is like asking our kids to put money in their piggy bank.

As our funds grow, it can sustain our club by ensuring we will be able to fund our own service projects that will. Projects that are difficult but give the most impact to those who are last on the line

to receive any aid or farthest from available help. When we can't give as much to The Rotary Foundation for whatever reasons, maybe our membership drops, or maybe the giving capacity of our members are reduced, our club will not be poor in projects because of the funds we have set aside in our own foundation.

The funds that we set aside are ours 100% year in and year out. So even in bad years when we may not give as much as we used to, our own foundation will be there to support us. And no, I'm not referring to our foundation using the funds that we had invested in to fuel our projects. I'm referring to income earned from the funds we gave, funds that will come to us in perpetuity.

But one cannot ignore the fact that The Rotary Foundation gives more bang for the buck due to its mechanics that allow us to to receive funds from global grant partners as well as the grant itself. Hence, I think a win-win formula would be to allocate two-thirds of our giving to TRF, and one-third to our piggy bank, CRCFI. I did the math and figured that if we can persevere and do this for 10 years, we would have 50 million in the bank! Can you imagine what it will be like when we hit 100?. I bet our charter members could not have Imagined that they would have 50 million after 100 years.

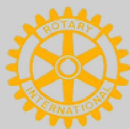

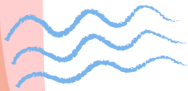
