Chartered on November 28, 1932, Rotary Club of Cebu is the second oldest club in the Philippines. The club currently has 63 members and prides itself in the quality of its members and the excellent fellowship that characterizes its weekly meetings.

The club sponsored the organization of several Rotary clubs in the Visayas and has produced six district governors, including Vicente L. Faelnar,

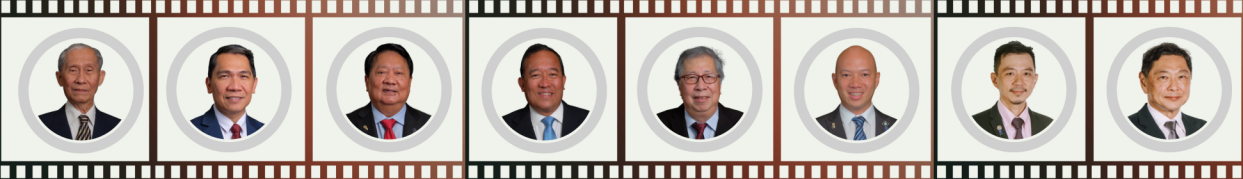
Joaquin Panis, Vicente Lozada, Federico Reyes and Manuel de Veyra. The latest, Edgar Chiongbian, was the District Governor in RY2013-2014 and also the RY2017-2018 Chairman of the Philippine College of Rotary Governors.

Rotary International District 3860 has consistently recognized the club for its role and contribution to the District, winning the Club of the Year and President of the Year awards multiple times over the years. Our members continue to donate generously to The Rotary Foundation and consistently leads

the District in TRF Donations and Disaster relief drives. The club has long led the district with the greatest number of Major Donors (15 currently) and in RY2019-2020, three members of the club (one posthumously) were inducted into the Arch Klumph Society, the first AKS members in our District. Likewise, RCC was the first club to establish a TRF Endowment Fund in the District. Lastly, the RCC has been very active in Global Grant projects, leading the country with almost 5% of the total approved Philippine global grant budget over the past six years.

WHAT HAPPENED LAST MEETING.....

With 66 members in our midst, we should have a deep bench when it comes to classification talks. And even then, each of us can also talk about our respective passions. Last week, we were privileged to hear from the man himself, PP Joe Soberano talk about the real estate business. As Chairman and CEO of Cebu Landmasters, Inc. speaks with great authority since heads a development company that has won numerous awards both regionally and nationally, many times over.

PP Joe acknowledged that times are not the best but cited how the industry has weathered numerous crises, from the 1997 Asian financial crisis to the 2008 sub-prime mortgage fiasco in North America. Even the pandemic, typhoon Odette and now the risk of a war in Europe confronts the industry. Yes, it brought a downturn in demand but bounces back in time. How it impacts a builder depends on where in the cycle of difficulties we are in.

The demand for residential units has not abated due to the huge backlog. Commercial and mixed-use developments do have their challenges, but he was confident it can be weathered. He talked of key elements that must be in place for a business to thrive. After all, the real estate industry is here to stay. He talked about the right ingredients needed to be in his business: The right funding, an organization to back it up, a real plan, clear calculations, and of course, a willingness to make the project beneficial to the community and labor market.

One thing I found interesting was how PP Joe used a term which never occurred to me. Products, referring to the space created when they build their properties. Products to me implied an item that I hold in my hands but to builders, products are residential, commercial or office space available for lease or sale. Makes sense.

PP Joe also pointed out to all of us that while most of us are not in the property business, we all have a stake in it since we own properties. So how the industry is affected also matters to us. So true.

PP Joe also gave us a sneak peek at what matters to him nowadays. And no, it's not about selling more and raking in profits. It's all about the environment. He talked about climate change and global warming. He talked about how as a developer he realizes that they too, have to consider the

ramifications of their business that can create a positive impact to the environment. He cited a book he recently got his hands on, "How to Spend a Trillion Dollars" that talks about how a trillion dollars can be used to change the world for the better. No, not in technology like AI or space travel, but in something more mundane like education, poverty, and equal wealth distribution.

It is a lot of money, but when you put it in context with the wealth available in this world, it is not much. But the lack of political will diverts these funds and resources into something more glamorous or sexy like robotics or space colonization. No doubt this book gave him an epiphany to take stock of what he's doing and dwell on ways by which mankind can make a difference.

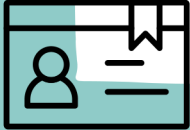

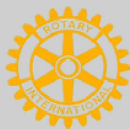
