Chartered on November 28, 1932, Rotary Club of Cebu is the second oldest club in the Philippines. The club currently has 63 members and prides itself in the quality of its members and the excellent fellowship that characterizes its weekly meetings.

The club sponsored the organization of several Rotary clubs in the Visayas and has produced six district governors, including Vicente L. Faelnar, Joaquin Panis, Vicente Lozada, Federico Reyes and Manuel de Veyra. The latest, Edgar Chiongbian, was the District Governor in RY2013-2014 and also the RY2017-2018 Chairman of the Philippine College of Rotary Governors.

consistently recognized the club for its role and contribution to the District, winning the Club of the Year and President of the Year awards multiple times over the years. Our members continue to donate generously to The Rotary Foundation and consistently leads the District in TRF Donations and Disaster relief drives. The club has long led the district with the greatest number of Major Donors (15 currently) and in RY2019-2020, three members of the club (one posthumously) were inducted into the Arch Klumph Society, the first AKS members in our District. Likewise, RCC was the first club to establish a TRF Endowment Fund in the District. Lastly, the RCC has been very active in Global Grant projects, leading the country with almost 5% of the total approved Philippine global grant budget over the past six years.

PRESIDENT'S INAUGURAL MESSAGE

June 24, 2023

Hector, PAG Robin and the warm welcome accorded to me by the members made me feel at ease.

I don't know what Mike saw in me to take me there. Perhaps he was again trying to dodge my sales pitch. But I thank him for taking me there. I also panicked for a minute upon hearing that my childhood tormentor who used to steal my lunch, a Bobong Castillo, was also a member of this club. But I was assured he had changed. And indeed, he has...he now tells everyone I stole his lunch!

But kidding aside, little did I know, that day would have such a profound impact in my life. It gave me a peek into what Rotary was all about as I listened to the Pres. gave his report about school chairs made by our club and donated textbooks that were distributed to remote public schools. And as he spoke, I told myself this is something I wanted to be involved in.

And it wasn't just about doing something good. You see, I had a long-standing principle – that when much has been given to me, the real reward is when I also share it with others.



That first meeting led me to a few more and I quickly saw how the impact of my sharing can exponentially grow when I do this with kindred spirits in an organization like Rotary. And the bonus was this: Because the club went out to remote communities that are less accessible or receive much attention, taking my family along these road trips presented a wonderful opportunity to introduce them to the realities of life of the less fortunate in this side of the world.

So not long thereafter, I found myself taking my oath to be a member of this wonderful club. The Rotary Club of Cebu eventually became our second family. Members became good friends and we all got to know their spouses and children. Road trips with Rotary gave them insights and lessons they can never get from schools. Truly I can say we couldn't have found a better way to settle into our new life and routine here.

7 years after taking that oath, I now stand before you, having been charged and taken a new oath to lead this club. It hasn't been an easy decision for as I look back at our illustrious Past Presidents, all I can say is "What have I gotten myself into?" I admit, yes, I have some experience and the qualities that make a leader. But it takes more than that to steer a club like ours. I felt I lacked the pedigree, more afraid to fail than I was of the job.

I had been asked to take this mantle years back, but I respectfully declined. Until

someone who was about to become our club President gave me a ring out of the blue. Those of you who know PP Edward know that despite his impressive background and wisdom, he carries all those with great humility. I looked up to him in many ways and getting a call from him is like getting a call from God.

He listened to my well-rehearsed reasons why I can't take that responsibility. But he had answers for all of them and topped it off by saying "Don't worry, the club members will come together for you, for you are doing this for the club."

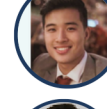
