Chartered on November 28, 1932, Rotary Club of Cebu is the second oldest club in the Philippines. The club currently has 63 members and prides itself in the quality of its members and the excellent fellowship that characterizes its weekly meetings.

The club sponsored the organization of several Rotary clubs in the Visayas and has produced six district governors, including Vicente L. Faelnar, Joaquin Panis, Vicente Lozada, Federico Reyes and Manuel de Veyra. The latest, Edgar Chiongbian, was the District Governor in RY2013-2014 and also the RY2017-2018 Chairman of the Philippine College of Rotary Governors.

consistently recognized the club for its role and contribution to the District, winning the Club of the Year and President of the Year awards multiple times over the years. Our members continue to donate generously to The Rotary Foundation and consistently leads the District in TRF Donations and Disaster relief drives. The club has long led the district with the greatest number of Major Donors (15 currently) and in RY2019-2020, three members of the club (one posthumously) were inducted into the Arch Klumph Society, the first AKS members in our District. Likewise, RCC was the first club to establish a TRF Endowment Fund in the District. Lastly, the RCC has been very active in Global Grant projects, leading the country with almost 5% of the total approved Philippine global grant budget over the past six years.

# CAUBIAN ISLAND RELIEF

## 2023.07.09

It's been more than a year and 6 months since typhoon Odette traversed the island of Cebu. The homes and buildings damaged by the winds have been repaired or rebuilt and the flora have bounced back. The only sign left would be some unrepaired structures when you travel to rural areas. For us, it is but a memory and we have moved on with our lives.

But for some far-off islands, it has been a slow hard slog. One such island is Caubian. We visited the residents soon after the typhoon to deliver humanitarian supplies more than a year ago. But since then, many of their homes still show temporary repairs, a patchwork of scavenged materials and tarp. It made me realize that sometimes, making do is good enough when one must worry about your next meal.

On July 9, 2023, members of the Rotary Club of Cebu and the Rotaract Club of Cebu journeyed once more to Caubian Island to distribute 1580 corrugated roofing sheets to 700 homeowners. Funding came from Rotary clubs abroad and was coursed to our District during the term of PDG Anna Bumagat.

Also in our midst were members of the Cebu Yap Fraternity Association led by their President Jonathan Gesalem, himself a Past President of RCC. They arrived with 800 bags of rice, thousands of packs of instant noodles, and water. They also donated a much-needed generator for the community chapel. Surely it was a good day for the islanders.

After the requisite remarks were delivered in their gym which was missing parts of the roof, we had one important task and that was to distribute 3000 donuts to hundreds of eagers children and adults. As they reached out for their Dunkin Donut, you could see the excited faces quickly replaced by a smile as they walked away with their goodie. It made me realize that for most of the children and many adults tied down by fate to their small island, savoring the taste of a donut would have made that day a special one.





Two and a half hours later, we departed the island, tired but buoyed by the smile and expressions of gratitude from the residents. I realized we were headed back to a life we know, where creature comforts and opportunities to enjoy life are often taken for granted.

I asked a minor who accompanied us and was in the thick of things how she felt about the activity. She said, "I enjoyed it. Because I know today, I helped make many people happy". And indeed, I dare say, spoke for us all. Rotary has once again made a difference in the lives of those who gave, and those who received.

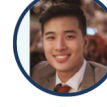
