I was informed by Past President Ricky Dakay that the Lahug Night (High) School

library project is ready for handover. This project was driven by PP Ricky's passion to provide a conducive environment and books available for students in our public schools. I know him to be very well read and no doubt he is helping create an public-school environment for our students to enjoy reading from a wellstocked library.

This project not only contributed to the rehabilitation Ωf their library equipped it with air conditioning, it also provided them with sturdy book shelves to hold the 3500 books that came from our own Books Program. The handover



In Cebu province, the program will be conducted in Talisay, Minglanilla, Naga, and Toledo. The activity of each location will be timed with the arrival of cyclists who will help promote the event by taking part in a 20km., 60km., or 100km. bike ride. This event is led by our Ride to End Polio Chair, Rtn. Edward Tan Ting with the support of our club's End Polio Chair, Rtn. AC Co. We have already reached out to the Mayors of each location as well as Presidents of Rotary clubs in our Area for their support and participation. Please stay tuned in the next week or two as we share more details about our role for the event.



Rotary District 3860 End Polio Ride 2023 - CEBU


Join us on September 10 as we launch another RIDE TO END POLIO event in Cebu! This activity is in support of Rotary International's global campaign to end polio.





WHAT IS THE GOAL OF ROTARY FOUNDATION GRANTS?

"DOING GOOD IN THE WORLD." THIS IS ACHIEVED VIA THREE PROGRAMS CATEGORIES OF THE ROTARY FOUNDATION.

DISTRICT GRANTS – ALLOWS UP TO 25% OF FUNDING GIVEN THREE YEARS AGO THROUGH ANNUAL FUND – SHARE TO DO PROJECTS THAT FALL WITHIN THE MISSION. 
