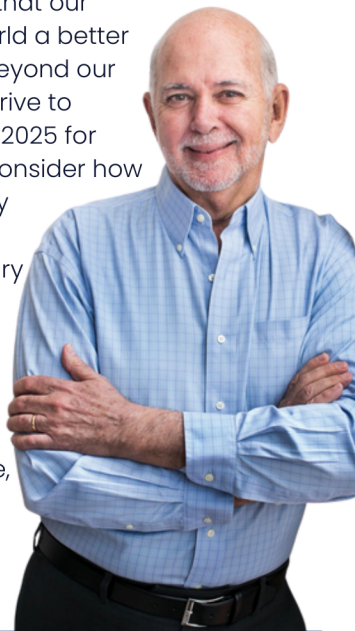

August 10, 2023

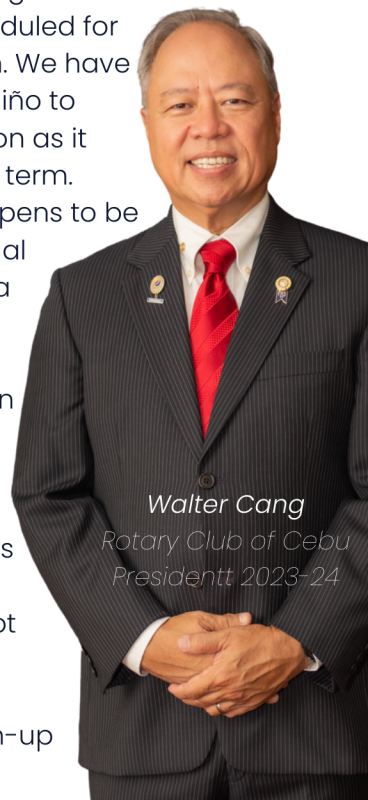
This week, I am sharing news about 2 service projects that fills me with great pride. Considered as one of the biggest, if not the largest Global Grant funded project in our District, the rehabilitation of Paypay National High School in Daan Bantayan is finally coming to an end. To date, over millions of pesos in funding has have been used to turn a typhoon ravaged public school into one of the best equipped public schools of the Municipality. So much work had been put into this service project it is hard to image the devastation wrought by typhoon Yolanda. I will not attempt to enumerate the work we did as it would be almost impossible to enumerate all of them and even if I did, it would still not do justice.

That is why I wish to invite our members, especially the Past Presidents who oversaw the project during their term to join us when we conclude this service project in a formal handover ceremony, hopefully in September. If you are one of the Past Presidents of our club from the last 9 years, I hope you will be there! The event will fall on a Saturday, and we plan to organize a fellowship at a nearby resort that evening.

I was informed by Past President Ricky Dakay that the Lahug Night (High) School

library project is ready for handover. This project was driven by PP Ricky's passion to provide a conducive environment and books available for students in our public schools. I know him to be very well read and no doubt he is helping create an environment for our public-school students to enjoy reading from a well-stocked library.

This project not only contributed to the rehabilitation of their library and equipped it with air conditioning, it also provided them with sturdy book shelves to hold the 3500 books that came from our own Books Program. The handover ceremony is scheduled for August 19 at 10am. We have invited IPDG Lilu Aliño to grace the occasion as it started under her term. This day also happens to be the District's annual Brigada Eskwela, a service activity designed to help schools clean up their premises in time for the start of the new school year. This new office will be owned by The Cebu Rotary Club Foundation, Inc. and I think the first business that will be conducted in our brand-new board room should be our own foundation, chaired now less than by its President, IPP Hector. If there is anything that can be said to represent our club, it is our office. You see, not only was it funded by our members, many of the things you will see inside are gifts from our members too. From our huge LED TV to the impressive conference table, the air conditioners, electronics, and appliances were all donated. Congratulations to everyone who made financial donations, dedicated their time and resource for a project of our very own club.

In closing allow me to inform everyone that in one month's time, we will be hosting the 2023 District-endorsed Ride to End Polio 2023. On Sunday Sept. 10, the District will be holding vaccination programs in General Santos, Cebu, and Ormoc cities. Butuan and Bohol, Tacloban and Davao will follow on October 22 and November 18 respectively.

In Cebu province, the program will be conducted in **Talisay, Minglanilla, Naga, and Toledo**. The activity of each location will be timed with the arrival of cyclists who will help promote the event by taking part in a 20km., 60km., or 100km. bike ride. This event is led by our Ride to End Polio Chair, Rtn. Edward Tan Ting with the support of our club's End Polio Chair, Rtn. AC Co. We have already reached out to the Mayors of each location as well as Presidents of Rotary clubs in our Area for their support and participation. Please stay tuned in the next week or two as we share more details about our role for the event.
