PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

October 19, 2023

It's great to be back after 3 weeks of being away. I missed several great meetings and events but I'm glad to know things went smoothly and I'm sure it was an enjoyable time. I must apologize if this article is a tad short as I had to unpack last night and this morning while battling the effects of jet lag. And as they say, no rest for the wicked, so it was back to the salt mines for me this morning and our Board meeting last night. Many thanks for Dir. Stanley and his family for hosting us in their beautiful home.

As you all know, Global Grants are an important part of our club's activities so each year, the President always takes stock of what grants are ongoing, and what new grants will be introduced. I can name 2 good reasons why we need to keep our finger on the pulse. One is to ensure the money that comes back to us each year from our TRF donations is put to good use and secondly, because every peso we pour into our global grant projects will invariably create something good in the lives of the less fortunate.

This year, one global grant project is sadly dead in the water. The African Ruggedized Education System aka ARES faced an insurmountable obstacle when we learned DepEd expressed little interest in adopting it for their needs due to their preference to use their own hardware and content. Since both were an integral part of the offering, we knew it wouldn't fly.

We're also facing a significant challenge with our proposal for WASH 4 when RI began putting in measures to ensure sustainability of the project. These include hydrological testing as part of the application process, and a 5 and 10-year plan from the stakeholders with regards to budget, consumables and upkeep. Since our WASH project is meant to benefit public schools in remote areas of

our province, you can imagine school officials and even DepEd will balk at this requirement. But we're not giving up on it yet. Our Project Chair, DJ Moises, continues to work closely with them in the hope of coming up with a suitable and attainable plan.

Another planned global grant project, the fitting our of Cebu's National Science High School laboratories are also facing difficulties due to

budgeting issues. I will be attending a meeting next week with the stakeholders and DPWH, who is responsible for the construction of the school building. After weeks of discussion, it looks like the hefty budget given for the project isn't going to go very far, at least in the eyes of DPWH. I will share the outcome of this meeting, and the project, by this time next week.

But there's good news to be shared as well. Our Gift of Life program continues to reap benefits and positive impact from our effort continues to roll in every week with more lives changes as we fight CHD. We're doing a bang-up job stretching our budget we're facing the problem of having budget remaining when more funds are ready to be released! It is a problem, but it is a good problem!

Looking at our list of activities in the coming months, it looks like it will be well packed with service projects and fellowship. A unique twist to our fellowship activities this month will be our Oktoberfest in the cold storage plant of Rtn. Bobong Castillo. Surely not to be missed. Our coral reef rehabilitation activity is also coming up in November. Many thanks to Dir. Brian Connelly for agreeing to host us once more in Jpark Island Resort. November is also our 91st Anniversary and we will be observing it in a much simpler way compared to last year's big event.

While waiting for our 2 containers of retired books from the states to arrive for our Books program, I also received word from our sister club, RC Makati, is inviting us to partner with them in helping distribute books through a partnership agreement with Rex Bookstore. This opens another window for us to source books for distribution through our network and surely will come to benefit school children in Cebu in the future.
