# TRUSTEE CHAIR'S MESSAGE

Barry Rassin Trustee Chair 2023-24

#### **NOVEMBER 2023**

This month, as we celebrate The Rotary Foundation, let's recognize it for what it is: one of the world's best humanitarian organizations.

Many charities, relief organizations, and nonprofits do the same type of work, and the public associates them with the causes they work on. But I wonder how many people know that Rotary supports those same causes seven of them in fact — which we call our areas of focus.

If they want clean water, good health, and a sustainable future for our planet, they support what our Foundation does. If they envision a world where peace, full literacy, and economic opportunities for communities to support themselves exist, they also believe in Rotary's mission. And if they want to see mothers and their babies thrive, their vision aligns with the work we do.

And we have a lot of work in progress through the Foundation. Polio eradication is changing the world, one drop of vaccine at a time. Rotary Peace Centers are training peacebuilders to reduce violence and resolve conflict. And through Foundation global and district grants, we are improving lives in a real way. global reach, with more than 48,000 field offices in the form of Rotary and Rotaract clubs. We emphasize good stewardship of your funds and efficient implementation of your projects. And we always aim for sustainable solutions.

During the 2022-23 Rotary year, the Foundation awarded 1,098 global grants. If you think of what a single grant can do, you begin to grasp the scale of our work and the magnitude of our impact — an impact people can see and feel in their daily lives.

Our district supported a global grant project that focused on basic education and literacy in Malawi, where we helped train 38 teachers who are responsible for 4,000 students. We also built two toilets and installed a pump, so they had water for drinking and hand washing.

I will never forget that when Esther and I visited the school, a young boy pointed to my Rotary pin, recognizing it from other volunteers who wore their pins during the project. He said, "I know you helped me. I won't be able to travel to thank the others who helped me, so please thank them for me."

So thank you, Rotary, on behalf of a child in Malawi whose future you made a little brighter, and on behalf of thousands of others you have helped by supporting The Rotary Foundation.

The way we work also sets us apart. We have

Their members are back for their third visit as we collaborate on the 3rd and final installment of Rotary Operation Save a Smile (ROSAS) to help Filipino children suffering from cleft palate and lips get their much needed surgery. Many of their members have become friends over the years and we have had the pleasure of visiting their club in the year past.

The past weekend was a busy one for our club as we chaperoned 65 Interactors from our community based Interact Club of Cebu in their first service project, 400 seedlings in Oprra of planting Barangay Kalunasan. It was great to see these children experience their first group activity and there was a lot of fun and laughter shared as they went around the grounds to plant their seedlings. Their Charter President, Brie Sia, did a great job organizing the event and since the young boys and girls are from different school in the city, they spent time after planting to partake in a Getting-to-Know-You game. I took the chance to share with them the

The following day, members of our club gathered at the Jpark Island Resort for our Coral Rehab and Shoreline Clean up activity. The event welcomed 24 Rotarians, friends and family members headed by Rtn. Joey Suaco who chaired this activity. After the requisite briefing from the dive team of the resort, the group split up according to the activity they wish to undertake. Some were scuba diving, a few tree planting, others went snorkeling and a few went walking along the shoreline to look for garbage that was brought in by the waves. Scuba divers were happy to report that corals planted last year have flourished and grown several times from their original size. Indeed it was very healthy and we agreed that in a few more months, they would be ready for transplanting into their final location.



Documenting our activity was none other than IPP February Canoy of RC Metro Mandaue 2006. She did a great job interviewing Dir. Brian and yours truly to give more context and depth to our activity. IPP February live streamed our activity on the Facebook accounts of both clubs and she was pretty good at it too! Truly a great example of how 2 groups can work together for a common good. Lastly, I wish to commend Dir. Brian Connelly for arranging the activity from the resort side. Without his help, this event would not have happened. All that hard work of course, led to a buffet lunch, which also led to another round of fellowship for the gang!



It was dubbed as a unique kind of fellowship and by golly it was! On Monday, October 30, soon after we did our civic duty and casted our vote in the local elections, we converged at the Big Blue Cold Storage facility in Tayud, Consolacion for a one of a kind gathering in a climate-controlled environment hosted by our very own Rtn. Bobong Castillo. Initially set at 10C, the cold didn't faze us as we donned cold weather jackets courtesy of our host. We were also fueled by an unlimited supply of steaming bak kut te, a Singaporean soup of pork ribs simmered in a broth of herbs and spices for hours, toasted baguette with cheese, spirits, and kegs of craft beer (to celebrate Oktoberfest of course!). The conversations, laughter and banter became louder and boisterous as the night wore on, evidenced by some of photos posted in our album! Later that evening, some among us had begun to feel the cold seep into our bones, so hot sake and an authentic Japanese soup called Oden were doled out. Our host was gracious enough to raise the temperature to 12 centigrade, then I suspect up to 15 degrees, just to ensure the night would last even longer! Later that evening, Bobong arranged a plant tour for the guests where they witnessed the operation of a completely autonomous Automated Storage & Retrieval Systems. Imagine racks many stories high in a dark room with machines that know where to pick the exact box in the middle of a cavernous hall. Very impressive. And they operated in varying temperatures, from as low as -28 up to a "warm" 3 centigrade. What an experience indeed! This unique fellowship wouldn't have been possible were it not for our host that evening, Rtn. Bobong and Lady Hyde Castillo, Not only for all the food they prepared, but for allowing us to occupy what would have been the very heart of their storage facility. Kudos also to our Fellowship Chair, PE Shige Onda who organized this singlehandedly. Bringing together the right kind of food, craft beer, and hot sake that complemented the venue. And true to his style of leaving no stone unturned, he even brought several appliances to serve them at the perfect temperature!

#### WHAT IS THE ROTARY FOUNDATION ENDOWMENT FUND?

If you will remember, The Rotary Foundation is funded in two different ways: the Annual Fund and the Endowment Fund (formerly the Permanent fund). The Permanent Fund enables individuals to combine their gifts into a significant force to address the world's greatest needs for generations to come. Donations to the Endowment Fund are made with outright gifts (cash, securities, real estate, tangible personal property or an Endowed Fund), life income agreements, or bequests by a will or trust.
