PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

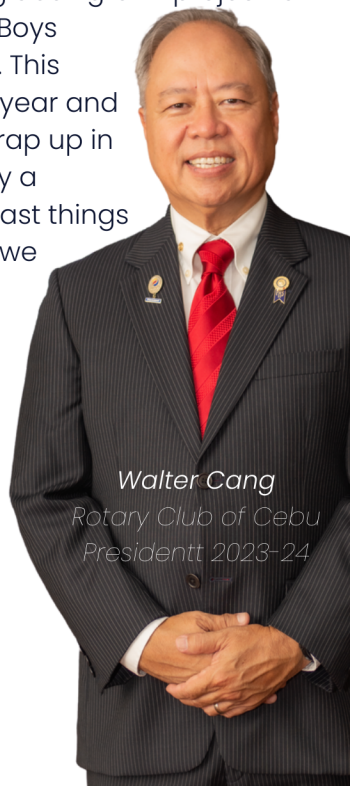
November 30, 2023

done mid to late morning and still have much of our Saturday to do other stuff.



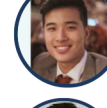
