PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

January 11, 2024

Hello everyone. We had a great start to our first meeting this year and while I normally focus on what is ahead of us, I will digress and cover briefly what was presented to us by AG Nancy Waters. It's interesting to hear how Rotary Shaped their children's lives and impacted their future. I know we're not active in the Rotary Youth Exchange program but we do know of Rotarians and friends who enjoyed their experience.

AG Nancy was aware that as a club, we may not have children who could take advantage of the RYE program, but she asked us to consider sponsoring a student who could benefit from living a life in a world far beyond the confines of his or her world. AG Nancy's daughter-in-law, Madison, grew up in a small town in Haliburton Ontario. I used to go to Haliburton to go camping and fishing, so I know when she said small town, it really is a small town.

Yet, through RYE, she was able to spend a year in Turkey and it completely changed her life. Imagine plucking a student from one of our schools in the hinterland of Calbasaan and dropping them in Seoul, Korea. Maybe not that drastic but close. And since the program arranges for a friendly family to take turns hosting the student for a year, it is easy to understand how it can change one's path in life in many ways.

On another note, I posted in our chat groups and I am reposting here because it is a significant topic that our members must know of. Next week, we will be inducting 4 new members into our club. They have gone through our vetting and screening process, and we are confident they will complement our culture and passion for fellowship and service. One other candidate is also expected to be

welcomed after completing his final prerequisite. When done, our club will gain 7 baby Rotarians in the last 6 months alone.

This represents a healthy growth of RCC and far exceed the District's goals set for Rotary clubs. It also tells us we need to schedule our mandatory one-day Orientation Seminar. This is to help baby Rotarians understand what Rotary is about and help them become Rotarians not
