

This year, Rotary International instituted new guidelines that dealt a death blow to our current and future plans to launch WASH projects. DJ bent over backwards to accommodate these requirements and bridge the gaps but received neither the concession nor support needed to keep it going. I'm sure you have seen the bulletins going out on our Viber chat groups about the different activities they undertook under his guidance. I have always voiced my sentiment on how these young Interactors need guidance and mentoring and he has taken this to heart as well.

In the coming days, I will be discussing with PP Bernard how we can institute a seamless transition so that our Interact Clubs will continue to enjoy the benefit of our guidance and encouragement.

ROTARY'S POLIO CHALLENGE

Rotary International and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation announced an extension of their existing fundraising partnership that could generate up to US\$525 million in new money for polio eradication as the global effort to end this crippling disease enters its critical endgame phase.

Under the new agreement, announced before an audience of more than 20,000 Rotary members from 160 countries gathered in Lisbon for the humanitarian group's annual convention, the Gates Foundation will match 2 for 1 every new dollar Rotary commits to polio eradication up to \$35million per year through 2018!
