

He is an IT expert with years of experience working with the biggest names in technology such as Microsoft, Google, Oracle, Salesforce, among others. Lee is now a Director at Databricks, which he describes as the "Google" of Netflix data and Al.

Lee is a triathlete, and he visited Cebu back in 2018 to compete the Ironman race. He lost his watch just days prior to the race and appealed for help to find a watch that he can use during the race. That was how he was introduced to Past President Bernard Sia, who not only assisted him, but also invited him to our club's luncheon meeting.



In our midst, he learned of our service projects and was touched by our members' passion to help our community. It was then than he decided to channel his own resource to help the less fortunate in Cebu through our club. RCC. He made another trip the following year, but the routine was disrupted by Covid 19. Lee's advocacy is now being implemented and

Not only did he extoll the virtues and promise of what Al can do, he also talked about its dark side, and the dangers it poses to human when used in an unregulated and unsuspecting world.

The takeaway of his talk can be best described as this: The disruption that follows in the next 3 to 5 years with the discovery and expected growth of Al, will one day be seen as one that is just as profound as the discovery of fire and electricity. CALBASAAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SHELTER



In 2023, over 30 Rotarians from District 3700 of South Korea visited Cebu to inspect one of their Grant Projects at the Calbasaan Global Elementary School in the mountains of Minglanilla. Moved by the sight of a destroyed classroom wrought by Typhoon Odette back in 2021, they passed the hat among themselves and raised over three hundred thousand pesos to go towards the repair of the classroom.


Sadly, the structure was deemed structural unsafe, and the only recourse was to demolish this. Mindful of the original intent of our visitors, we searched for additional funds and found one hundred thousand pesos remaining from the District's disaster fund to augment our budget.

Even then, we knew it was not enough to build a new classroom, but we decided the next best thing. Construct a sturdy shelter that can be used as an outdoor classroom and still shelter the students at this remote hinterland school from the rain and sun.



WORDS FROM A PAST ROTARY FOUNDATION AMBASSADORIAL SCHOLAR:

"THE ROTARY FOUNDATION'S PROGRAMS ARE ALL THE MORE IMPORTANT BECAUSE WE LIVE IN A WORLD OF SHARP CONTRASTS: FEAR AND HOPE, ILLNESS AND GOOD HEALTH, POVERTY AND WEALTH. 


