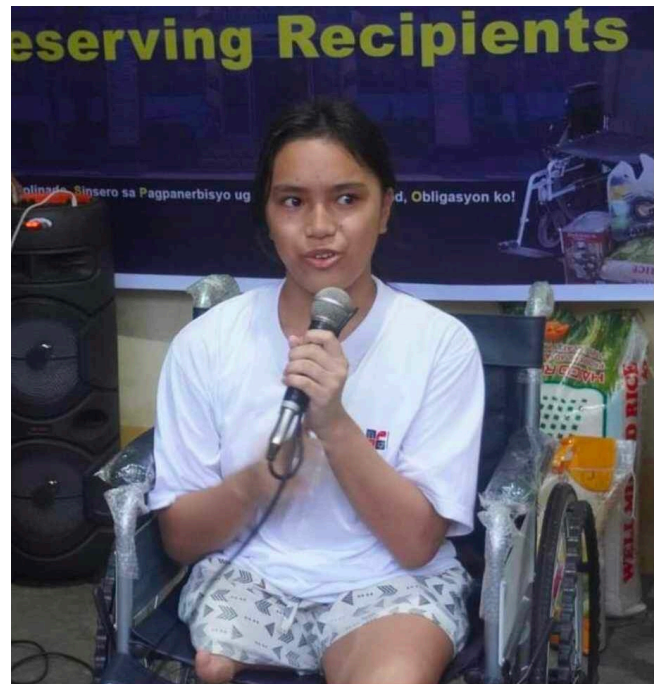
Beyond the mobility aid, the project extended its reach by providing essential support to the community. The beneficiary not only received
