Fourth The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, & peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

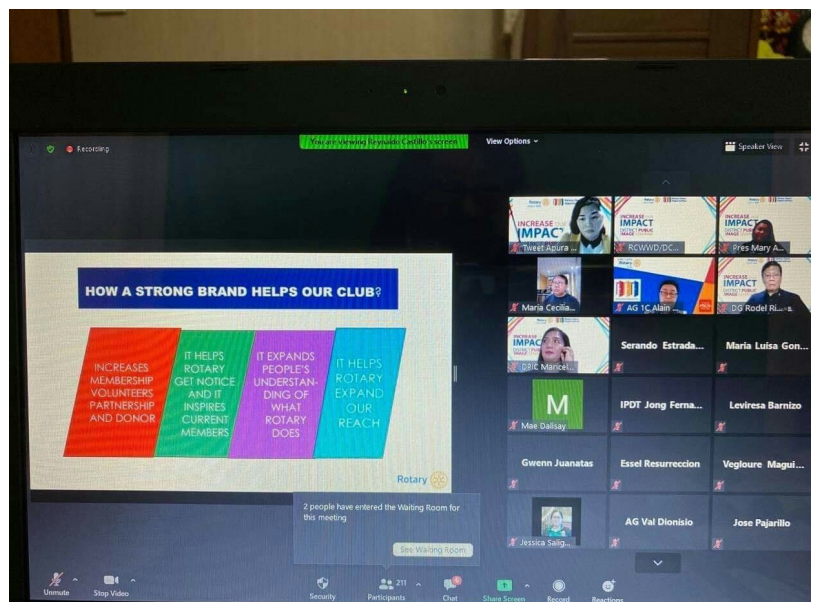
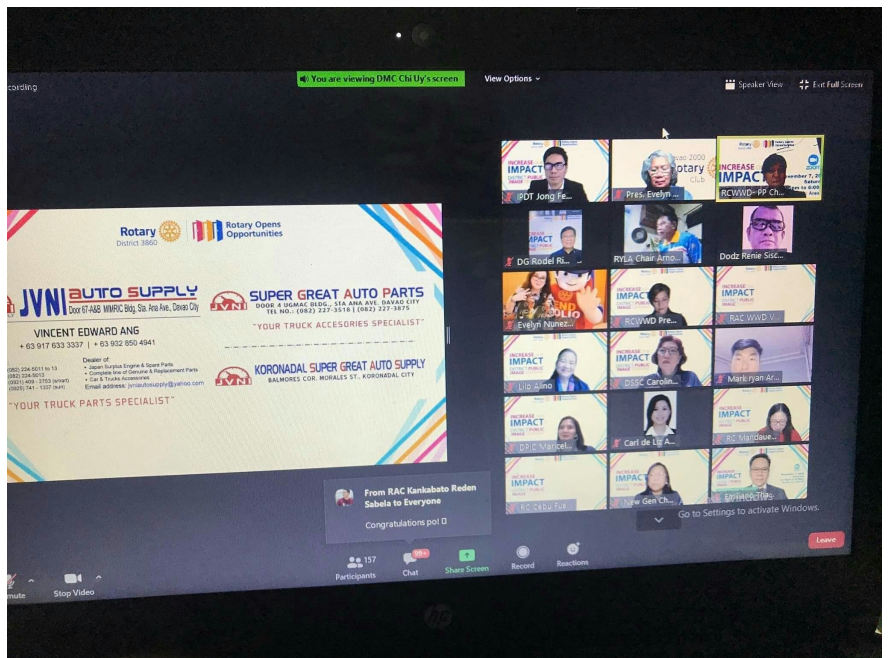
Rotarian Code of Conduct

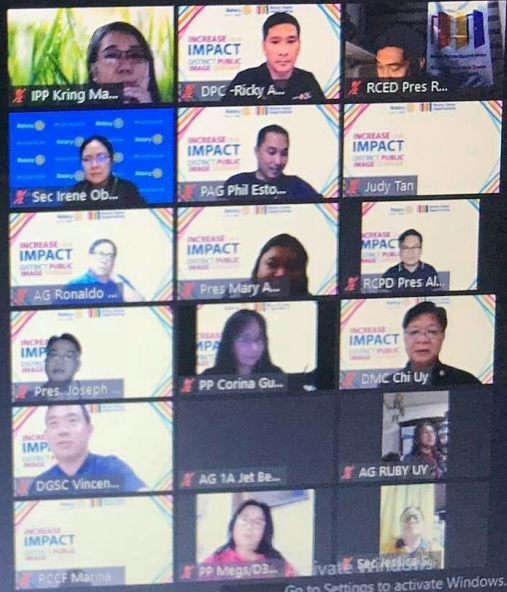
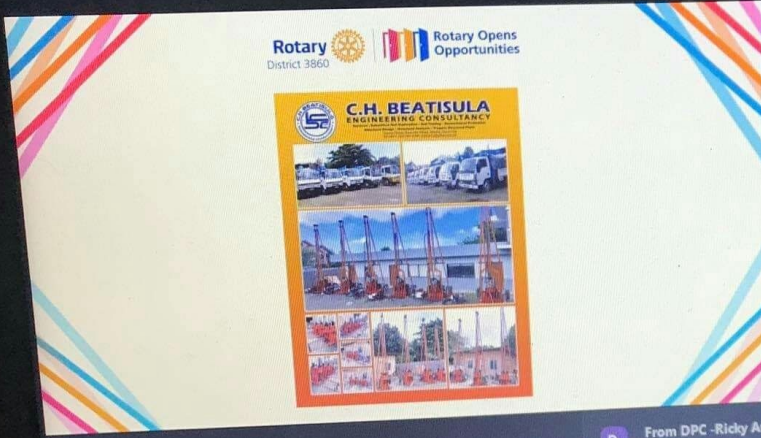
