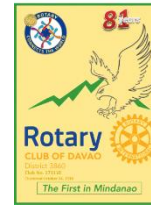

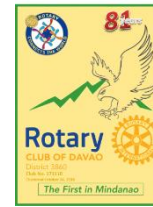
The meeting was also an avenue for Rotarians to meet and greet each other whom they have not seen for a period of time.

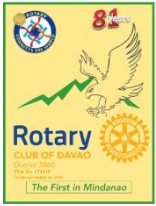

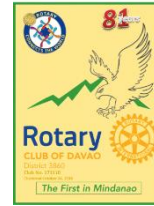

Chambers appeared in the occasion. Also in attendance is PDG and RC Davao Honorary Member Bading Angala.



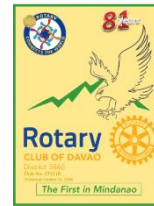

8. Not seek from a fellow Rotarian a privilege or advantage not normally accorded others in a business or professional relationship.



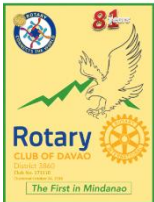

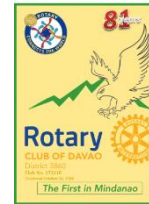

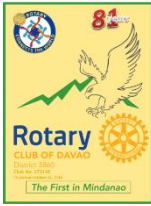


## DECLARATION OF ROTARIANS IN BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONS

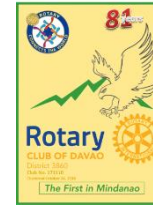
As a Rotarian engaged in business or profession, I am expected to:
