There were more than 300 cyclists who joined and registered from Digos City and the neighboring towns.

Through the event, The Club was able to raise a sum of Php 29,000. We are aiming to use this fund in buying new jetmatic pumps and water filters for our adopted community in Hagonoy, Davao del Sur.

The primary objective of the said activity is to collect a variety of blood products that will be utilized in saving the lives of the beneficiaries of the Philippine Red Cross.

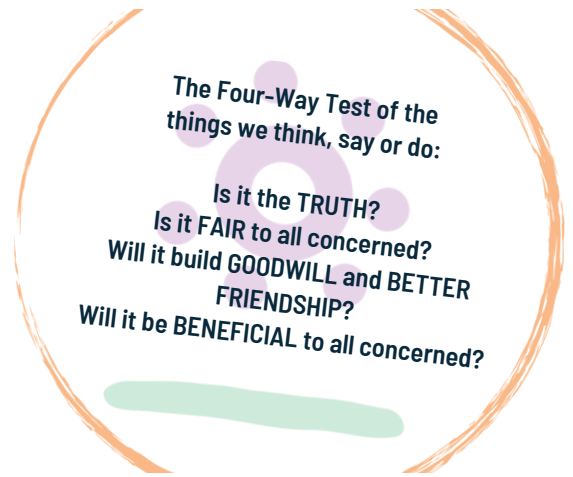


The blood letting activity successfully collected 26 bags from the donors. This is the second activity done with the Rotary Clubs of Area 2E from Rotary Club District 3860.
