

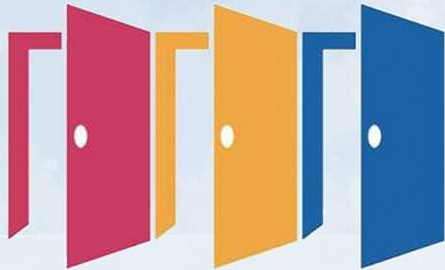

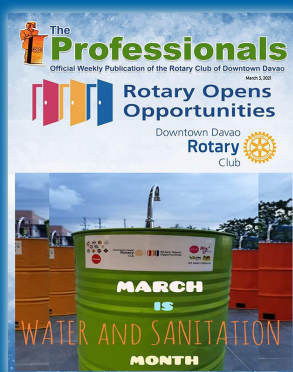

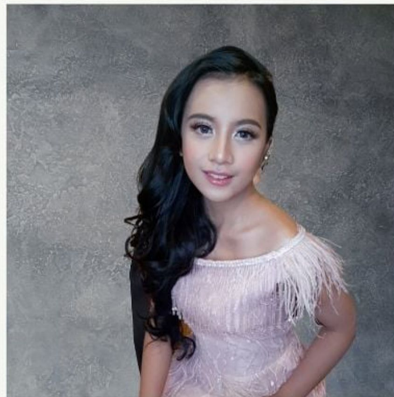
FAMILY OF ROTARY

The Rotary Club of Downtown Davao signed and Memorandum of Agreement between Department of Education Region XI and Alternative Learning System. This agreement is the result of GLOBAL GRANT in partnership with Rotary Club of Pulaski County, Missouri District 6080 represented by District Governor Jacqueline Howard.

This is an innovative solution to adapt the new normal by taking the RC Downtown Davao's Existing rotary school of hope online and on television. Existing rotary school of hope online and on television. Students at the school will benefit. They are youth in conflict with the law, youth in drug or habitation centres, youth with disabilities, youth belonging to indigenous communities, youth victims of violence and violent extremism. The school Annabelle student to finish high school through the Department of Education's of Alternative Learning System.

This project will provide educational equipment and supplies to expand the ALS in the community learning centre for children in conflict with law. Because of the Covid-19 pandemic, the facility is still functioning but a limited capacity in order to observe social distancing protocols. The global Grant will support the purchase of needed equipment and educational supplies to provide the alternative learning system online for student in the program.

ROTARY CLUB OF DOWNTOWN DAVAO

RCDD'S HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS
RY 1993-1994 to RY 2020-2021

Chartered on February 23, 1993, RCDD started as an all-women service club with 27 lady executives of varied professions and vocations, led by Charter President Evelyn A. Magno, who became the first Lady District Governor in RY 2005-2006. The whole Rotary world was then celebrating the 88th Foundation Anniversary of Rotary International, when RCDD became the 29,258th Rotary club all over the world, and the 79th club in District 3860.

Only on its first year, RCDD was already blazing the trail and raising the bar for Rotary clubs in the District, winning awards and recognitions year after year, either as Most Outstanding Club, President, Secretary, Club Bulletin, and/or other Service Awards, with the following as the most significant:

RY 1993-94: the only club in the District to get the RI Presidential Citation for a "Balanced Club Achievement Award". An awardee as the "Most Outstanding Club, President, Secretary and club bulletin" in the District for category III (New clubs). Club President: CP Evelyn A. Magno.

RY 1998-1999: winning a grand slam of all District major awards: "Most Outstanding Club, President, Secretary, and Club Bulletin (The Professionals)". Club President: Linda C. Tesoro.
